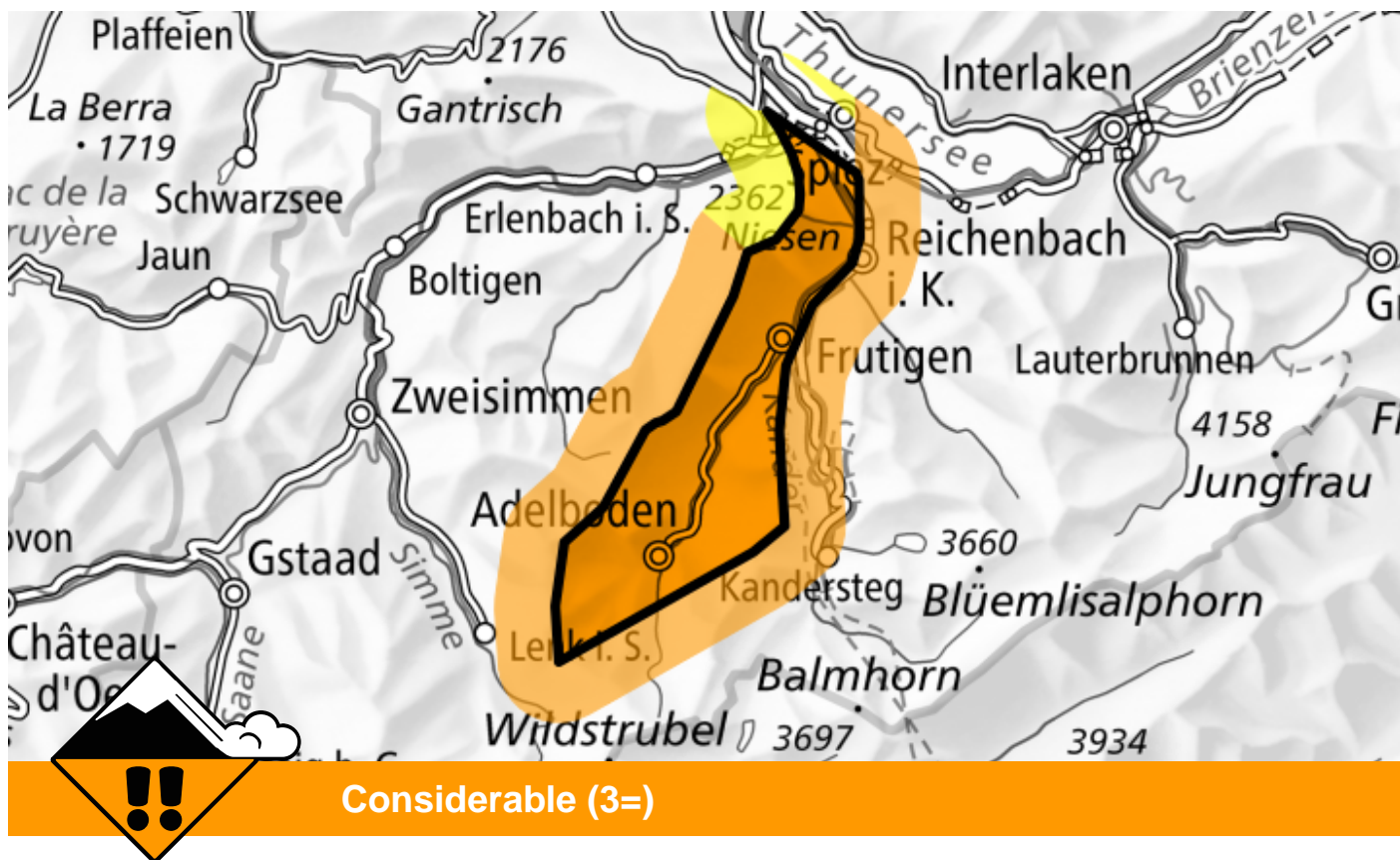


Avalanche danger

Avalanche prone location Danger description



As a consequence of a strengthening southerly wind, avalanche prone wind slabs will form over a wide area. In the course of the day these will increase in size additionally. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches. These can reach large size in isolated cases. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

Moderate (2)

Wet snow, Gliding snow

Gliding avalanches are possible. These can in isolated cases reach large size. This applies on steep south facing slopes in particular below approximately 2400 m, as well as on north facing slopes in particular below approximately 2000 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible. In addition moist loose snow slides are possible, in particular on very steep sunny slopes.
