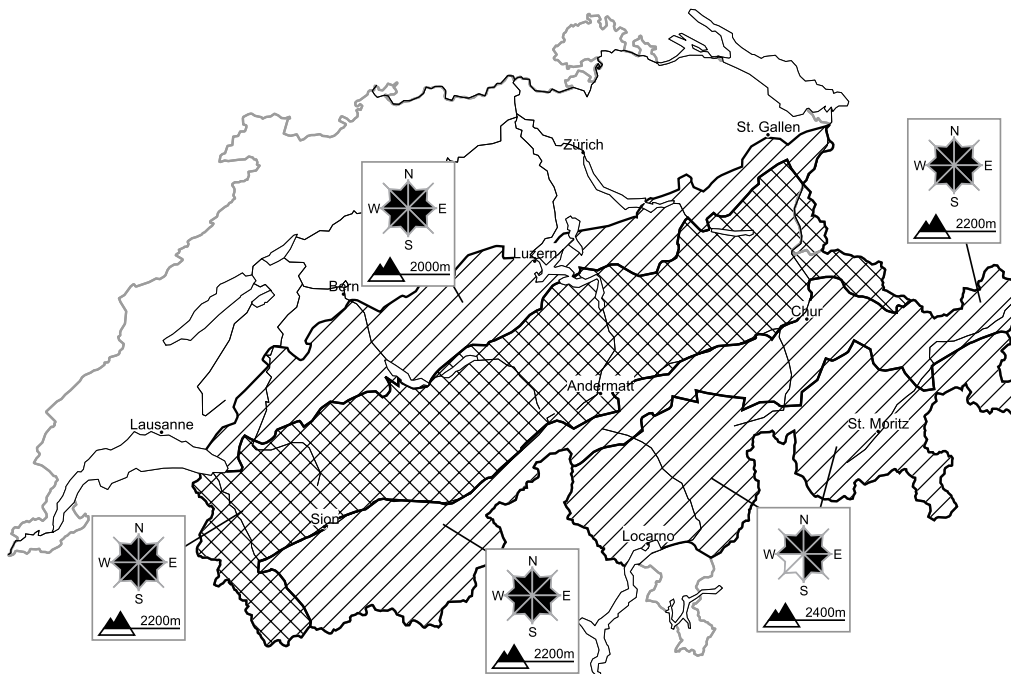


Significant increase in avalanche danger as a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather, in particular in the north

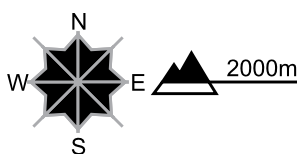

Avalanche prone locations



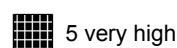
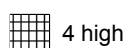
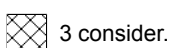
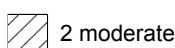
Danger description

At elevated altitudes snow drift accumulations will form. These are in some cases prone to triggering. The avalanche danger will increase a little during the day. Backcountry touring and snowshoe hiking call for careful route selection.

Below approximately 2000 m moist snow slides are to be expected as a consequence of the rain.
