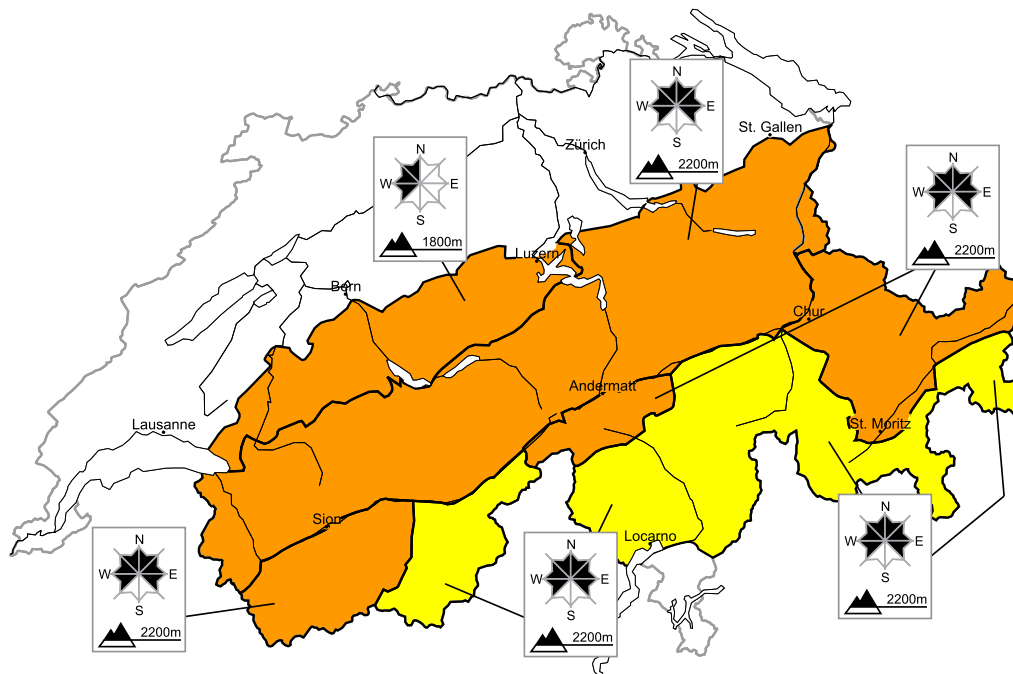


# Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

## Avalanche danger



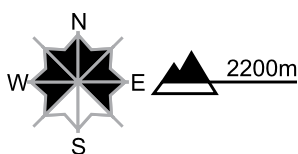
**region A**

#### Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in some cases still prone to triggering. Avalanches can in some places be released by a single winter sport participant. This applies especially at transitions from a shallow to a deep snowpack. Avalanches can in isolated cases be triggered in near-ground layers and reach medium size, in particular on north facing slopes. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

### Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes full-depth avalanches are to be expected. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
