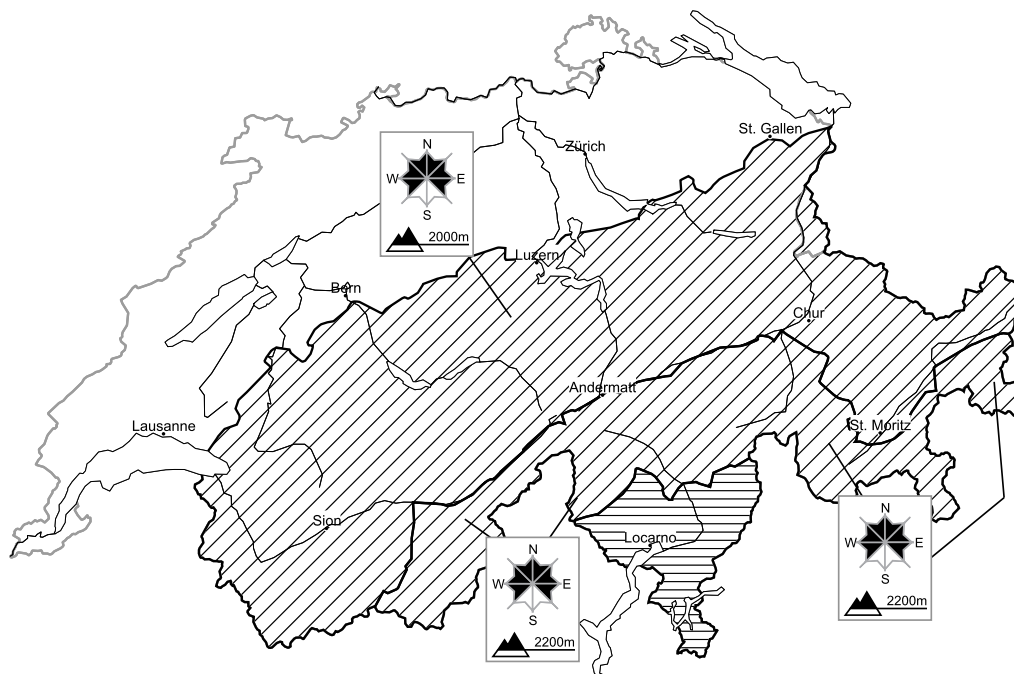


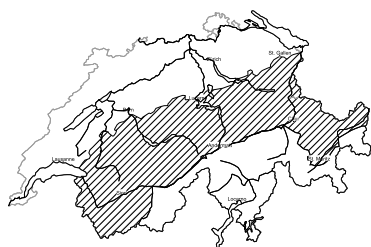
Weak layers in the old snowpack necessitate caution

Avalanche danger

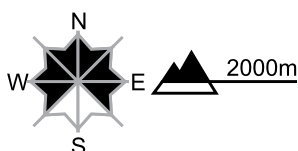


region A **Level 2, moderate**

Danger description

In some places avalanches can be triggered in the old snow and reach medium size in isolated cases. Caution is to be exercised in particular at transitions from a shallow to a deep snowpack. The avalanche prone locations are barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for defensive route selection.

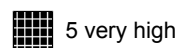
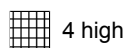
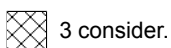
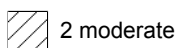
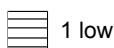
Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes full-depth avalanches are to be expected. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

Remarks

The Avalanche Warning Service currently has only a small amount of information that has been collected in the field, so that the avalanche danger should be investigated especially thoroughly in the relevant locality.
