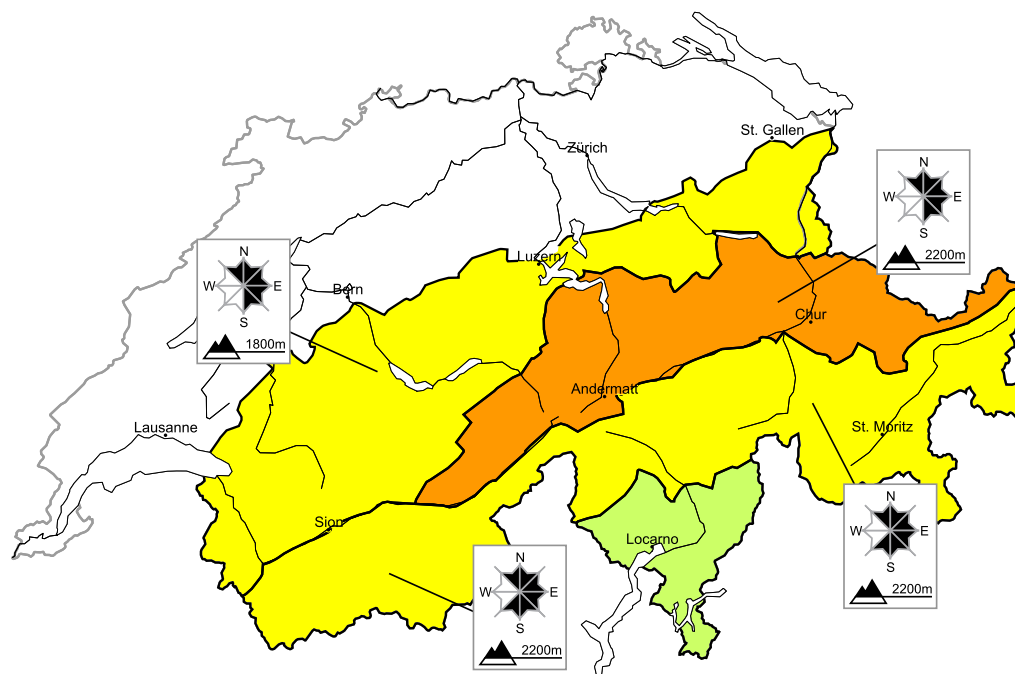


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Fresh snow drifts are to be avoided

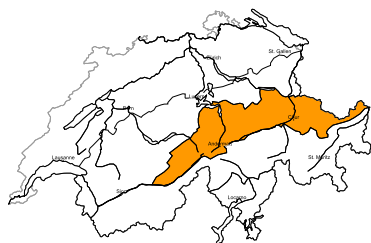

Avalanche danger



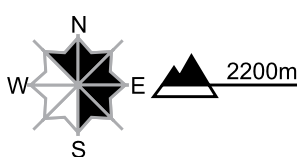
region A

Danger description

The snow drift accumulations of Sunday are lying on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack in particular on north and east facing slopes. They can in some cases be released by a single winter sport participant. At elevated altitudes the prevalence and size of the avalanche prone locations will increase. The snow drift accumulations are clearly recognisable to the trained eye. They are to be avoided in steep terrain.

Avalanches can in very isolated cases penetrate deep layers and reach medium size. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
