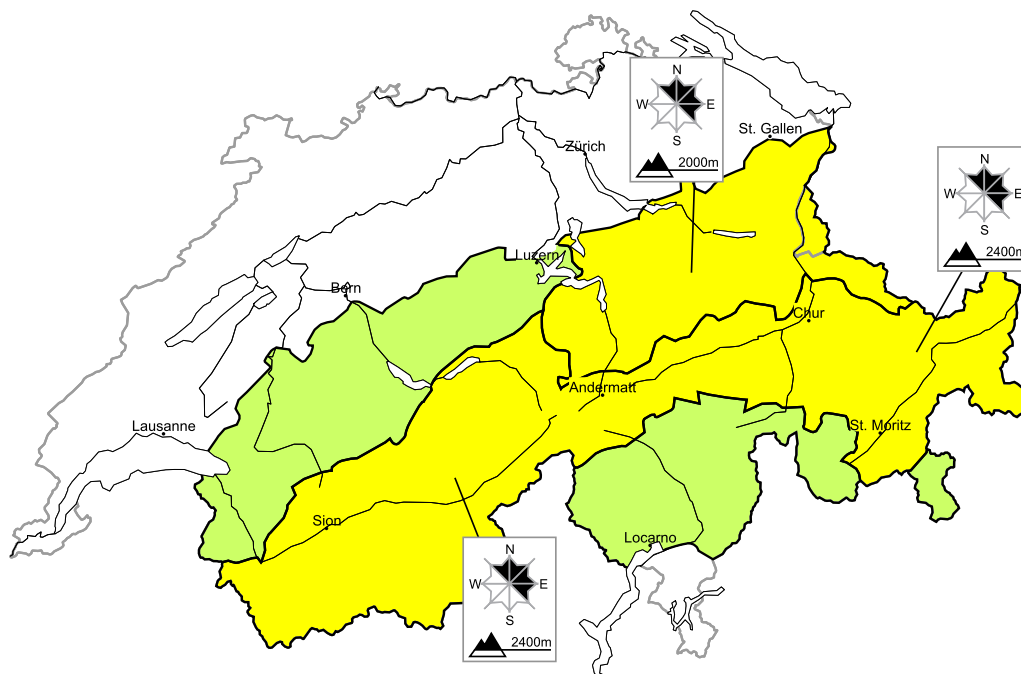


Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

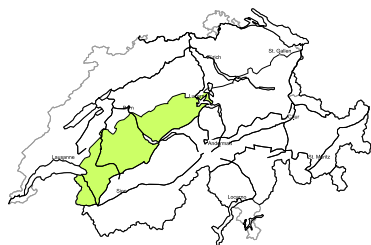

Level 1, low



Snow drifts

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. They are mostly small and can be released in isolated cases especially at their margins. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised in particular in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

Full-depth avalanches


On steep grassy slopes small full-depth avalanches are possible. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.


Remarks

The Avalanche Warning Service currently has only a small amount of information that has been collected in the field, so that the avalanche danger should be investigated especially thoroughly in the relevant locality.
