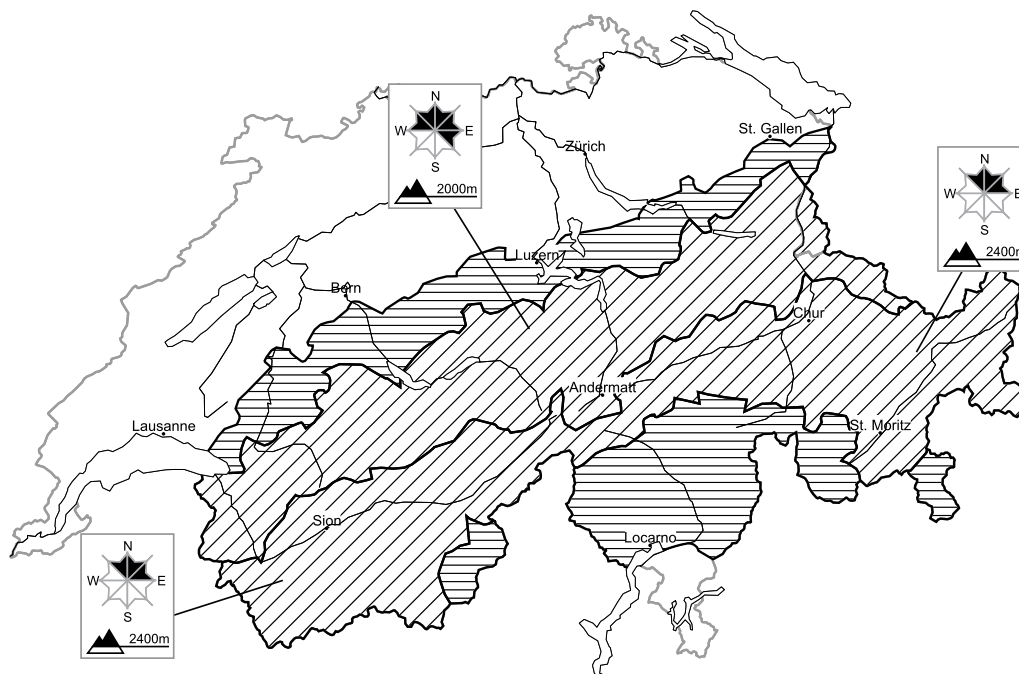


Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

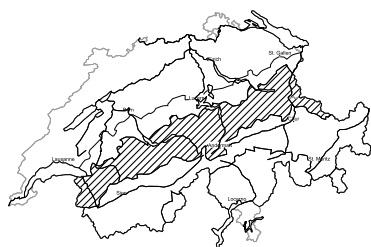

Avalanche danger



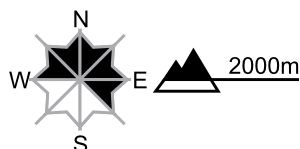
region A

Danger description

Fresh snow drift accumulations are mostly small but can be released easily. They are to be evaluated with care and prudence in particular in steep terrain. Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in the old snowpack and reach medium size. This applies in particular on very steep shady slopes. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection.

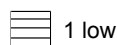
Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes full-depth avalanches are to be expected. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

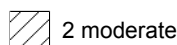
Remarks

The Avalanche Warning Service currently has only a small amount of information that has been collected in the field, so that the avalanche danger should be investigated especially thoroughly in the relevant locality.

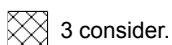
Danger levels



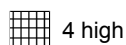
1 low



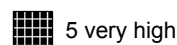
2 moderate
