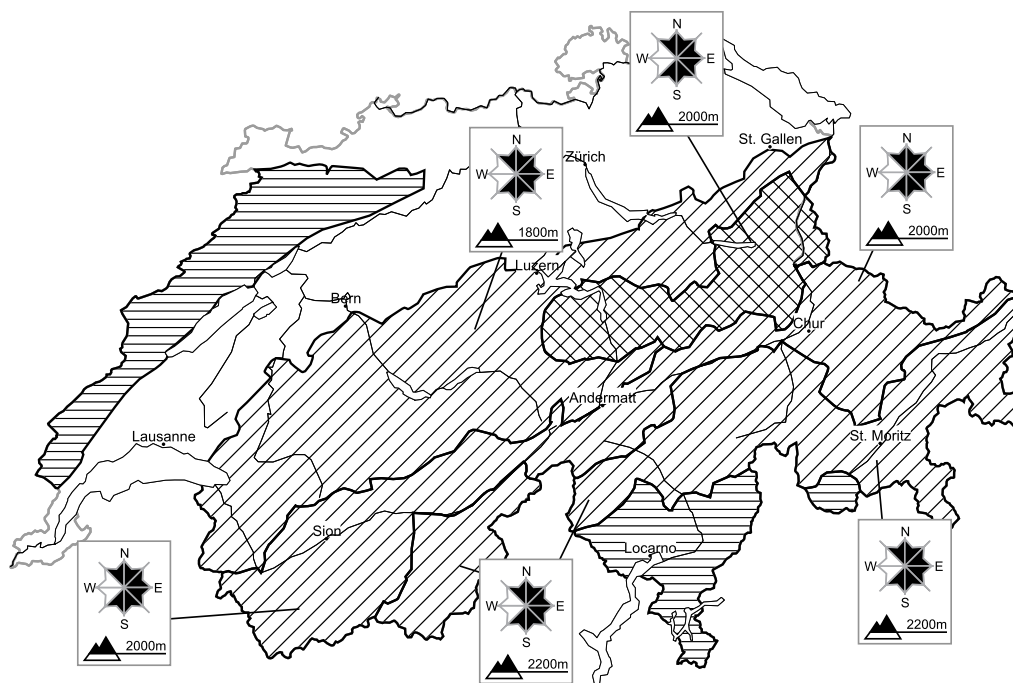


In the northeast a considerable avalanche danger will prevail. Snow drifts require caution

Avalanche danger



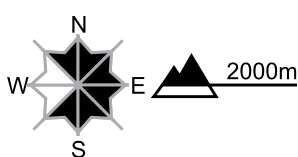
region A

Avalanche prone locations



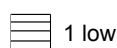
Danger description

As a consequence of the southwesterly wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Fresh and somewhat older snow drift accumulations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. They can be released by a single winter sport participant. Avalanches can in isolated cases reach medium size. Ski touring and other off-piste activities, including snowshoe hiking, call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

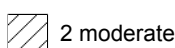
Remarks

The Avalanche Warning Service currently has only a small amount of information, so that the avalanche danger should be investigated especially thoroughly in the relevant locality.

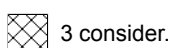
Danger levels



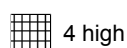
1 low



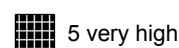
2 moderate
