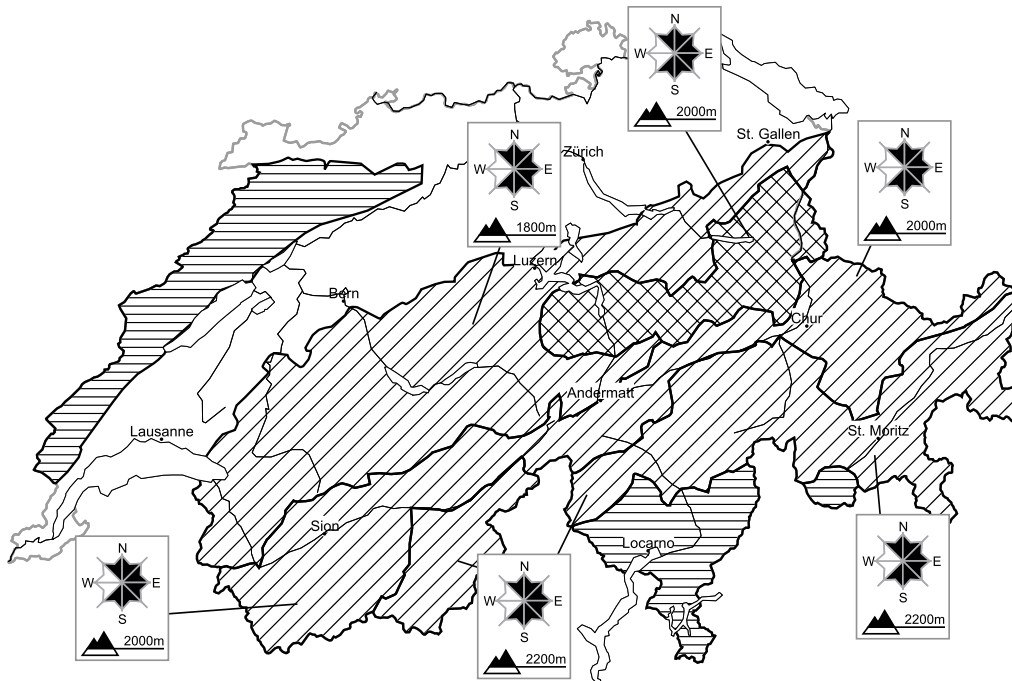


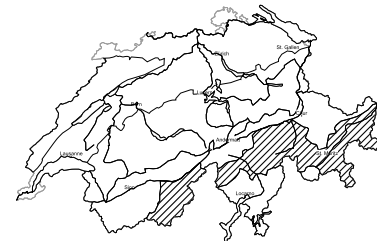
**In the northeast a considerable avalanche danger will prevail.

Avalanche danger

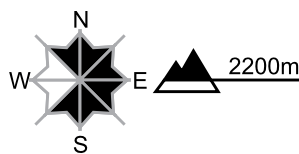


region D Level 2, moderate

Danger description

Thus far only a little snow is lying. In the last two days snow drift accumulations have formed. They are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls. They can in some cases be released by a single winter sport participant, but they will be small in most cases. Additionally in very isolated cases avalanches can be released in the old snowpack and reach medium size. This applies in particular on steep shady slopes. Ski touring and other off-piste activities, including snowshoe hiking, call for careful route selection.

Remarks

The Avalanche Warning Service currently has only a small amount of information, so that the avalanche danger should be investigated especially thoroughly in the relevant locality.
