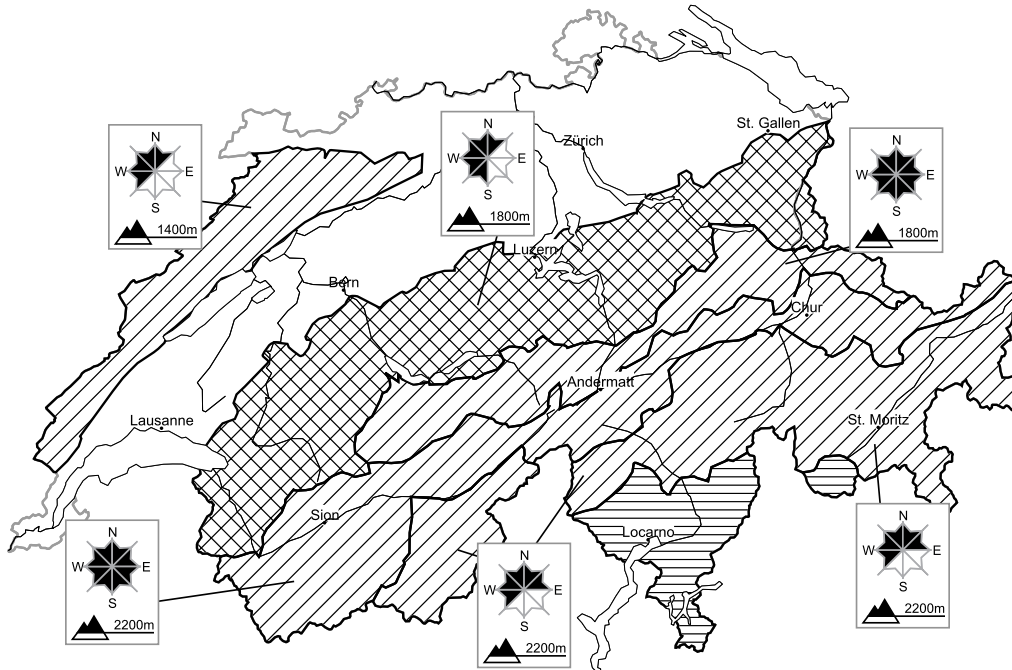


Fresh snow drifts are to be avoided. Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

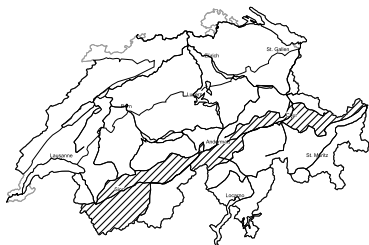

Avalanche danger



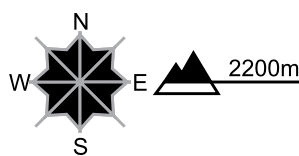
region C

Danger description

The easterly wind will transport the loosely bonded old snow. Fresh snow drift accumulations will form in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls, especially at elevated altitudes. They can in some cases be released by a single winter sport participant, but they will be small in most cases. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls. Additionally in very isolated cases avalanches can be triggered in deep layers. This applies in particular on steep, little used shady slopes. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection.
