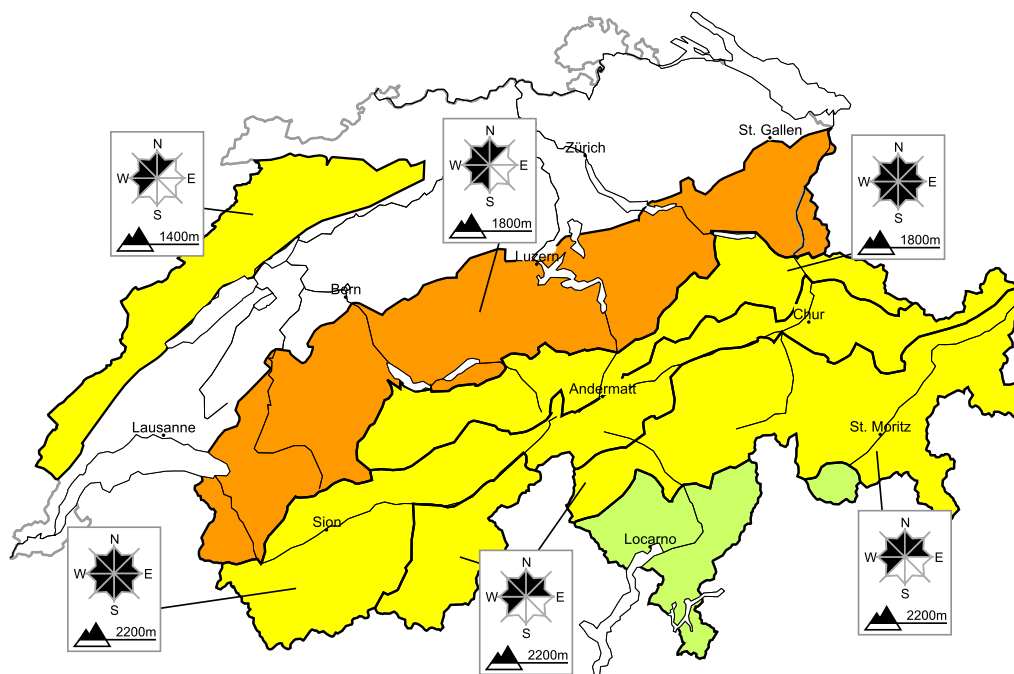


Fresh snow drifts are to be avoided. Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

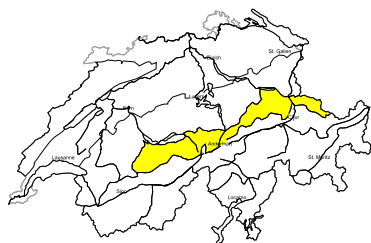

Avalanche danger



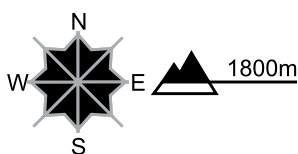
region B

Danger description

The easterly wind will transport the loosely bonded old snow. Fresh snow drift accumulations will form in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls. They can in some cases be released by a single winter sport participant, but they will be small in most cases. At elevated altitudes the prevalence and size of the avalanche prone locations will increase. The fresh snow drift accumulations are clearly recognisable to the trained eye. They are to be evaluated with care and prudence in steep terrain. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for meticulous route selection.
