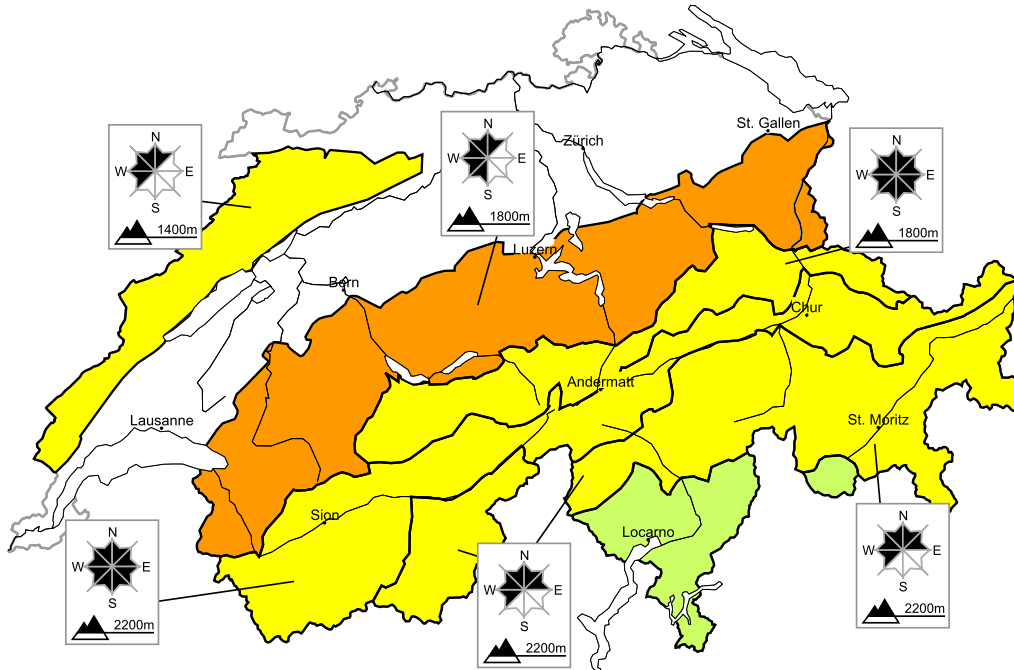


# Fresh snow drifts are to be avoided. Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

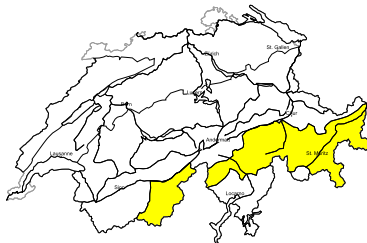

## Avalanche danger



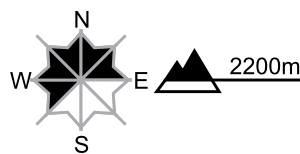
**region D**

#### Danger description

Thus far only a little snow is lying. Snow drift accumulations are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls. They can in some cases be released by people, but they will be small in most cases. In high Alpine regions avalanche prone locations are a little more prevalent. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised in particular in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls. Additionally in very isolated cases avalanches can be released in the old snowpack. This applies in particular on very steep shady slopes. Careful route selection is recommended.
