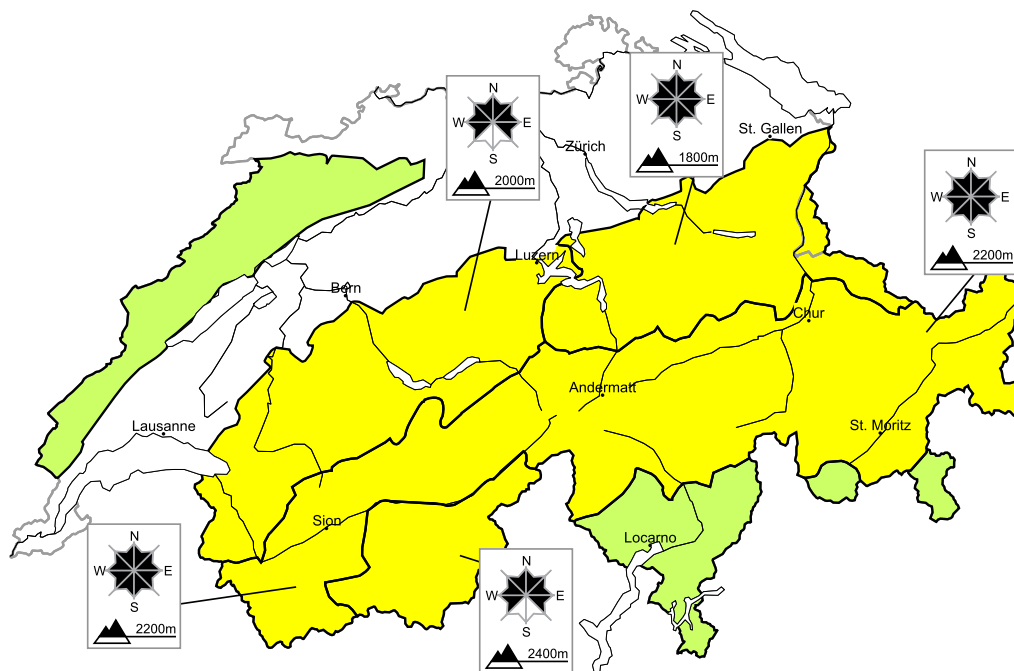


## Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

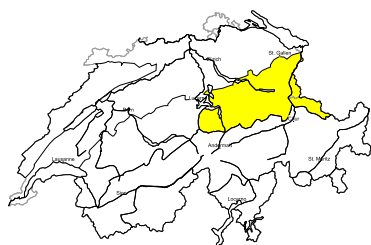

### Avalanche danger



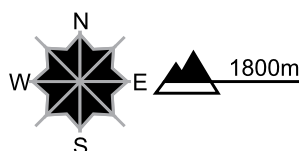
region A

#### Fresh snow and snow drifts

##### Danger description


The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. Mostly the avalanches are small. The avalanche prone locations are sometimes covered with fresh snow and therefore difficult to recognise. Careful route selection is required.


#### Full-depth avalanches

Mostly small full-depth avalanches are possible on steep grassy slopes. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2200 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.
