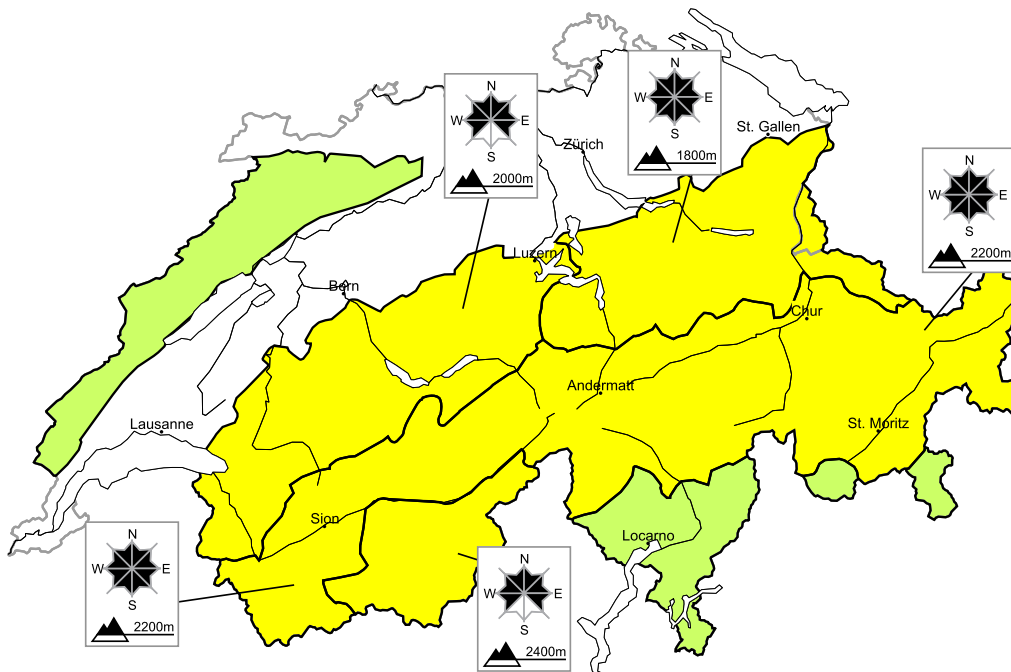


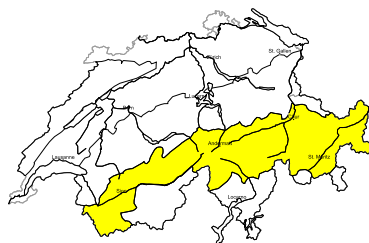

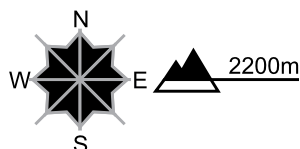


region B **Level 2, moderate**

Danger description

The mostly small snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. At elevated altitudes the snow drift accumulations are larger. These avalanche prone locations are sometimes covered with fresh snow and therefore difficult to recognise. Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in the old snowpack. This applies in particular on steep, little used slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rare. Isolated whumpung sounds can indicate the danger. Careful route selection is required.

Full-depth avalanches

Mostly small full-depth avalanches are possible on steep grassy slopes. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2200 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.
