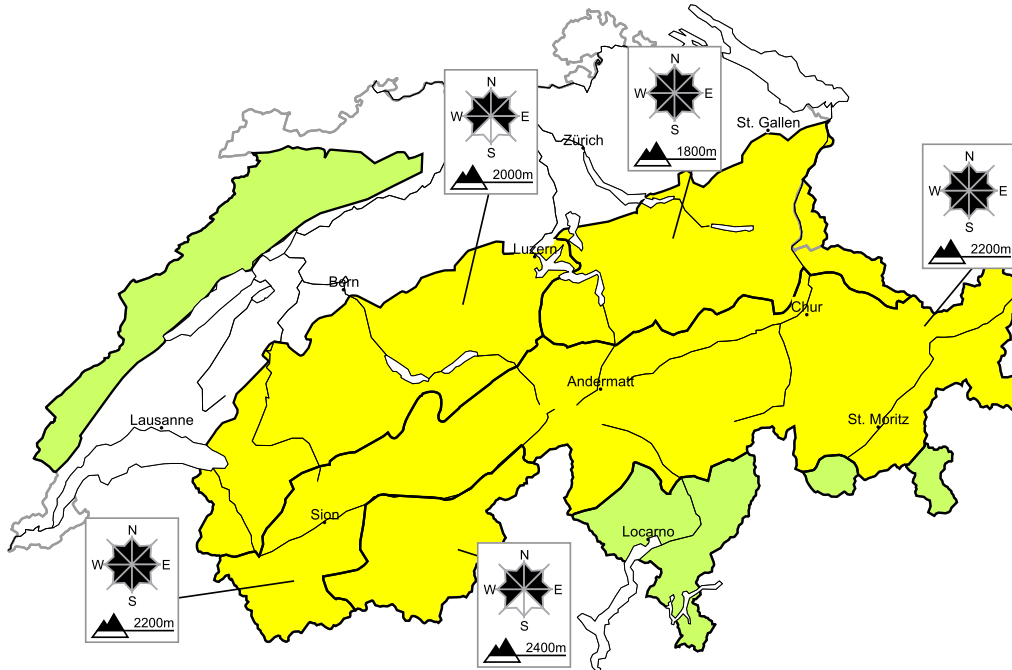


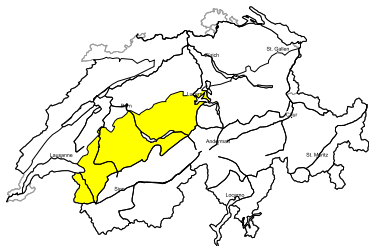

Avalanche danger

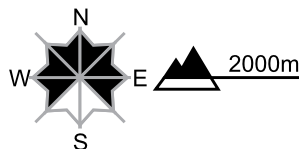


region C **Level 2, moderate**

Danger description

Avalanches can be released in near-surface layers, mostly by large additional loads. Careful route selection and spacing between individuals are recommended.

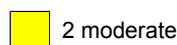
Full-depth avalanches

Mostly small full-depth avalanches are possible on steep grassy slopes. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2200 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

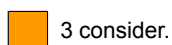
