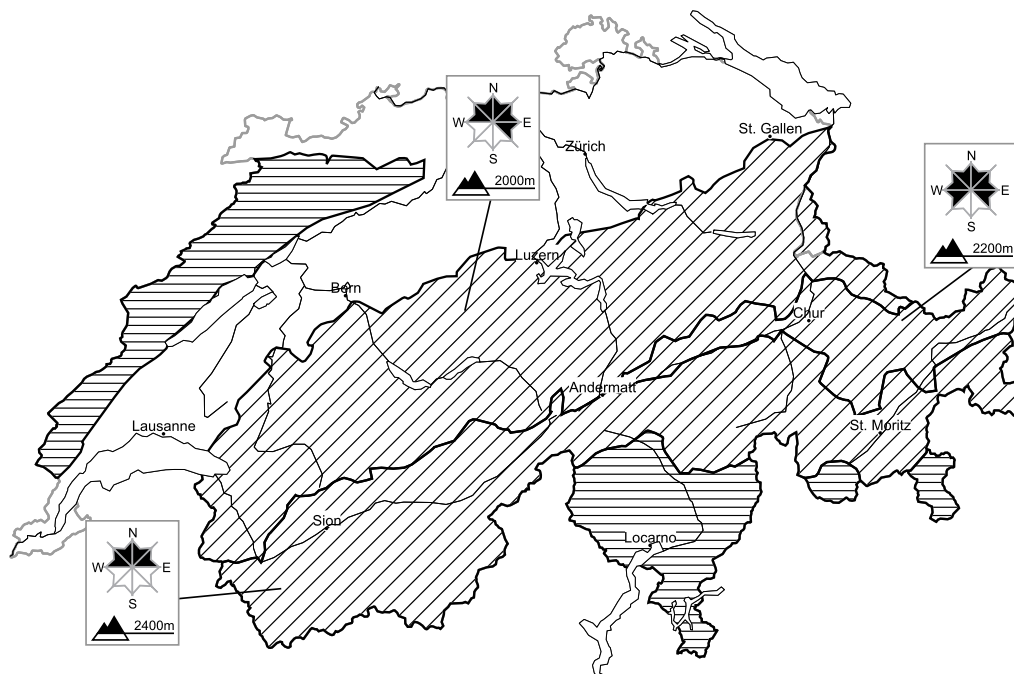

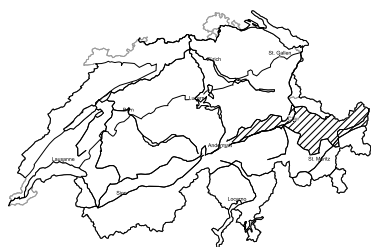

Avalanche danger



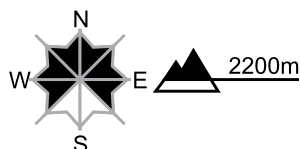

Avalanche prone locations



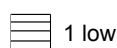
Danger description

The mostly small snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. At elevated altitudes the prevalence and size of the avalanche prone locations will increase. Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in the old snowpack. This applies in particular on steep, little used slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rare. Isolated whumpfung sounds can indicate the danger. Careful route selection is required.

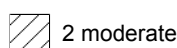
Full-depth avalanches

Mostly small full-depth avalanches are possible on steep grassy slopes. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2400 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

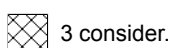
Danger levels



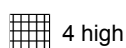

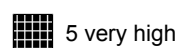
2 moderate
