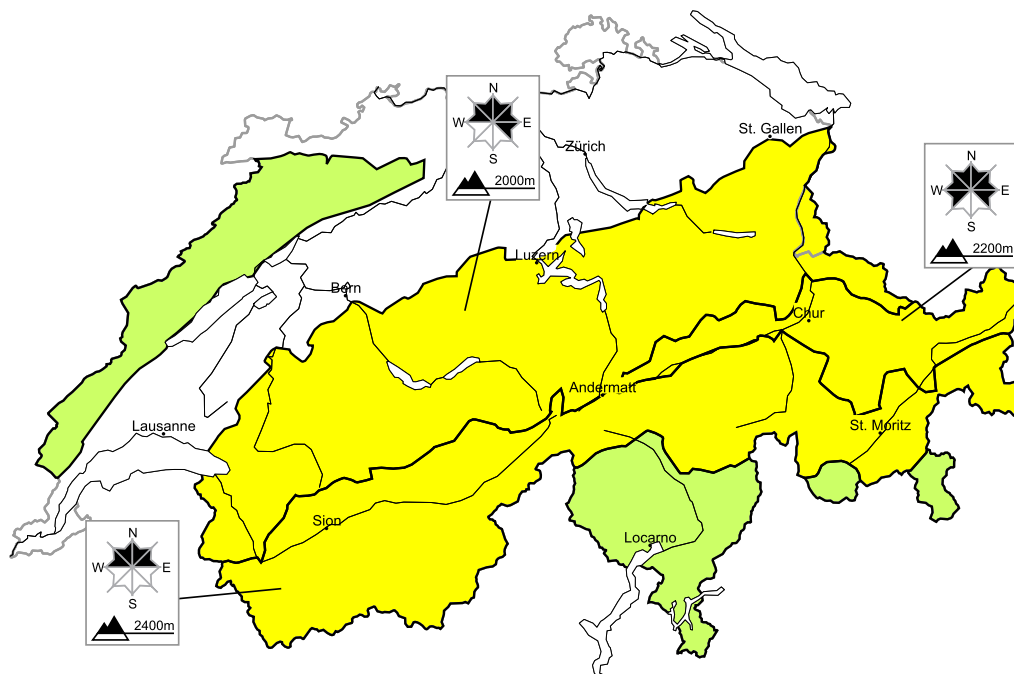


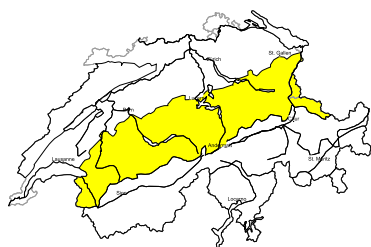

Avalanche danger

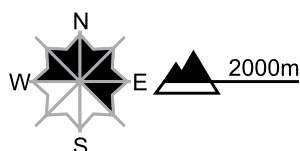


region A **Level 2, moderate**

Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations are in some cases still prone to triggering. As the day progresses mostly small snow drift accumulations will form. They are to be bypassed as far as possible. Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in deep layers. This applies in particular on steep, little used slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rare. Isolated whumpfung sounds can indicate the danger. As the day progresses small snow drift accumulations will form.

Full-depth avalanches

Mostly small full-depth avalanches are possible on steep grassy slopes. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2400 m as well as on north facing slopes below approximately 2000 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.
