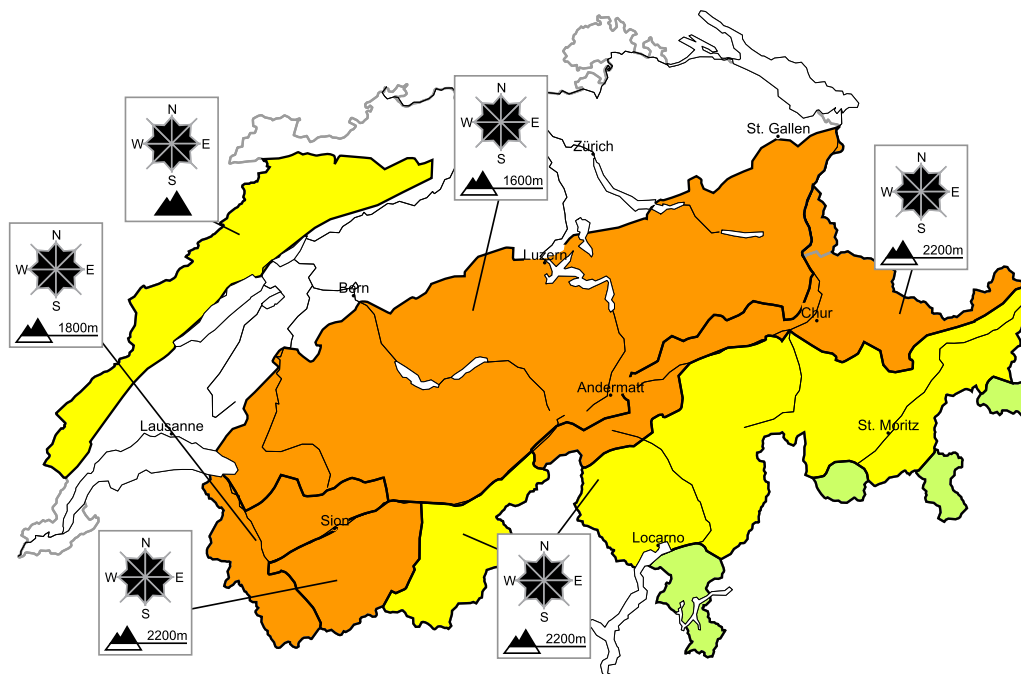


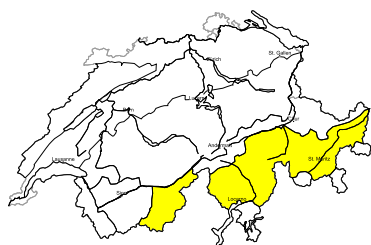

Avalanche danger

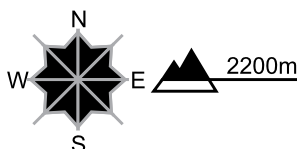


region E **Level 2, moderate**

Danger description

The sometimes storm force wind will transport the fresh snow and, in some cases, old snow as well. The fresh and older snow drift accumulations can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. Mostly the avalanches are small.

Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in the old snowpack. This applies in particular on steep, little used slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rare.

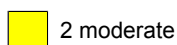
Careful route selection is recommended.

The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase as the day progresses. Upper Valais: Until the evening danger level 3 (considerable) will be reached.

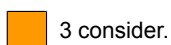
Danger levels



1 low



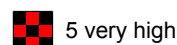
2 moderate
