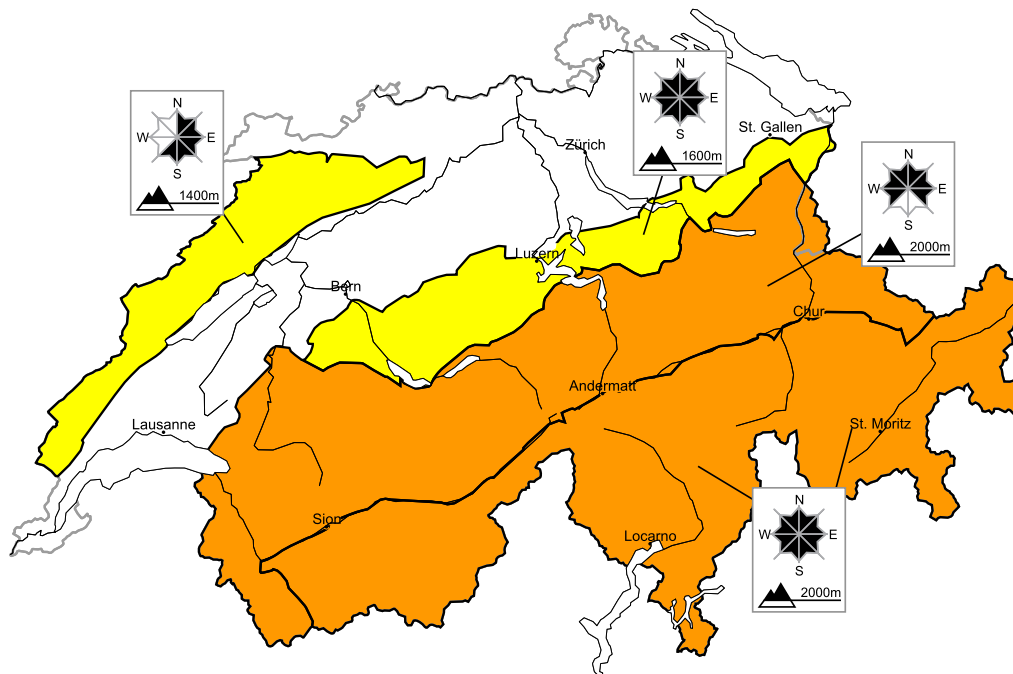


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

Avalanche danger



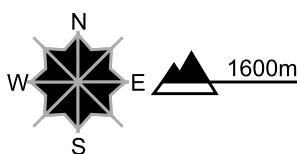
region C

Danger description

The large snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released in isolated cases, but mostly only by large additional loads. Small and, in isolated cases, medium-sized avalanches are possible. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection.

As the day progresses mostly small snow drift accumulations will form. These are to be evaluated with care and prudence.

Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes more full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2400 m as well as on north facing slopes below approximately 2000 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
