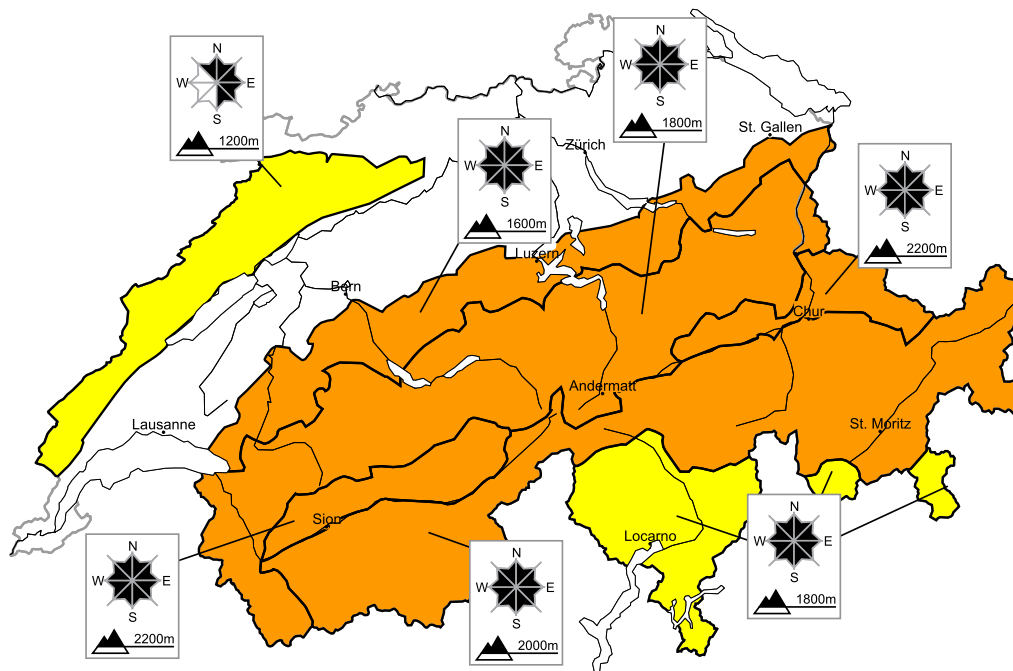


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

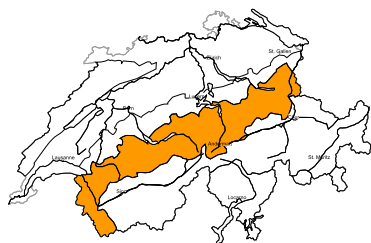

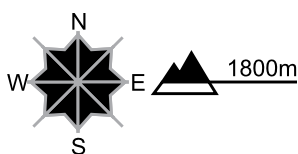
region A

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days can still be released in some cases. As a consequence of the northerly wind avalanche prone snow drift accumulations will form. Avalanches can be released, even by a single winter sport participant and reach dangerously large size. Individual natural avalanches are possible.

Ski touring and other off-piste activities, including snowshoe hiking, call for experience and restraint.

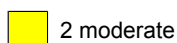
Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes small to medium-sized full-depth avalanches are to be expected. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2400 m as well as on north facing slopes below approximately 1800 m. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

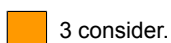
Danger levels



1 low



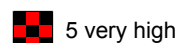
2 moderate
