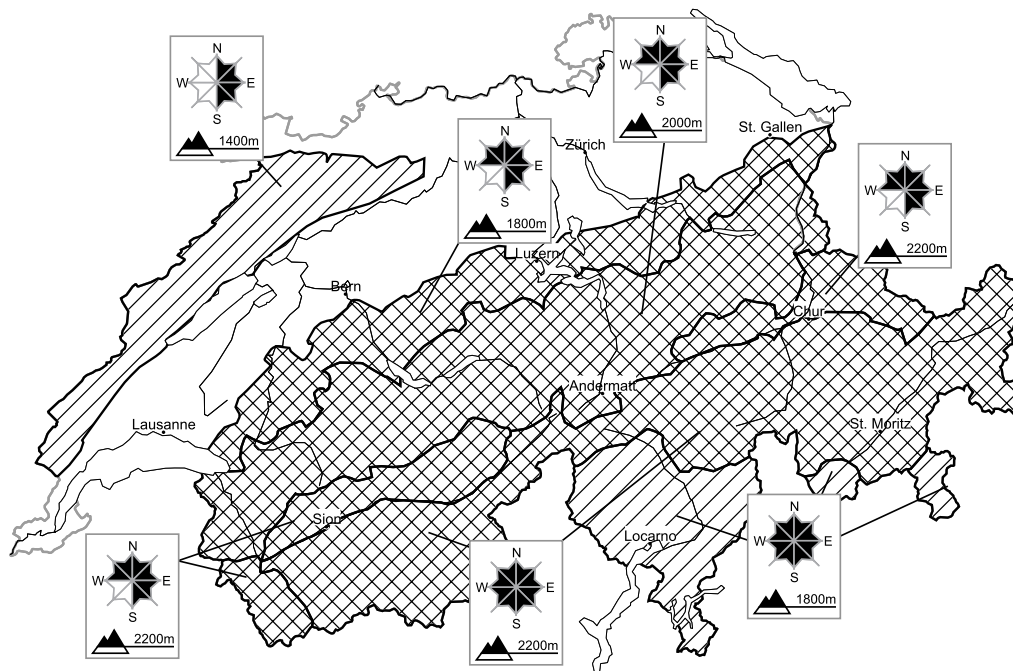


# Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

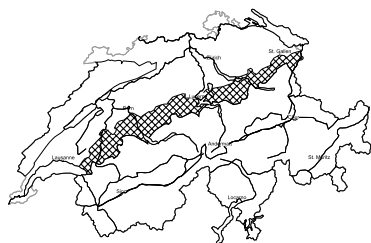

## Avalanche danger



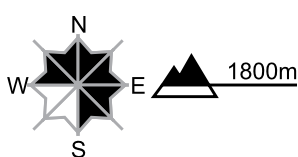

##### Danger description

As a consequence of the westerly wind avalanche prone snow drift accumulations have formed. Avalanches can be released, even by a single winter sport participant. Mostly they are small.

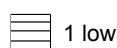
The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of last week can still be released in some cases. This applies in particular in areas where the snow cover is rather shallow.

Ski touring and other off-piste activities, including snowshoe hiking, call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

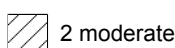
#### Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes small to medium-sized full-depth avalanches are to be expected. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

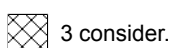
#### Danger levels



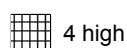
1 low



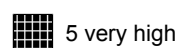
2 moderate
