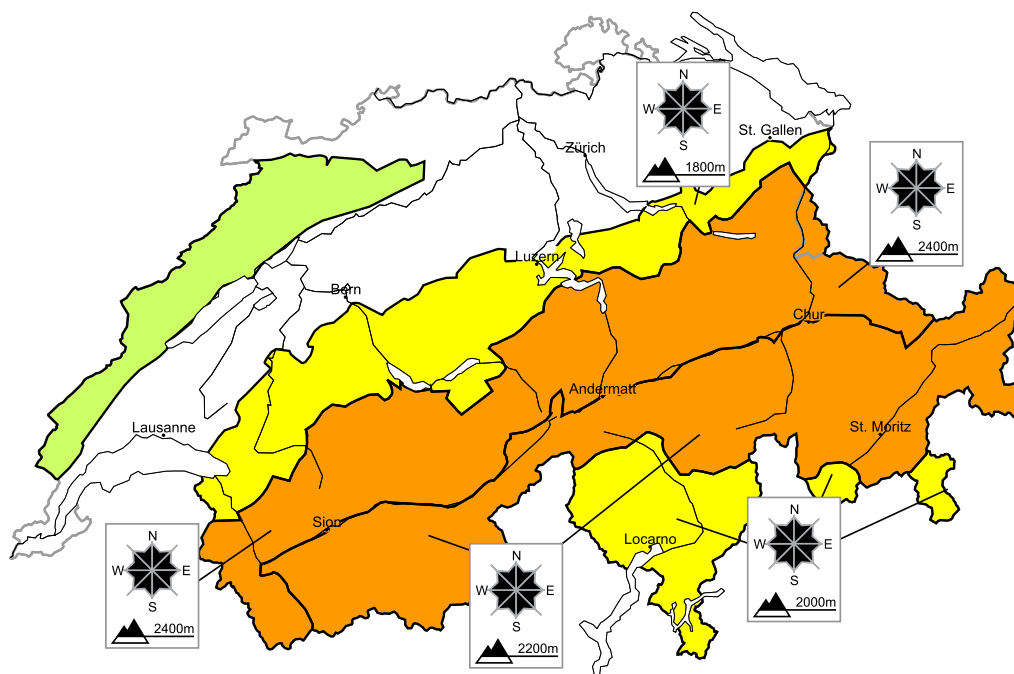


At elevated altitudes a considerable avalanche danger will prevail. Snow drifts and weakly bonded old snow require caution

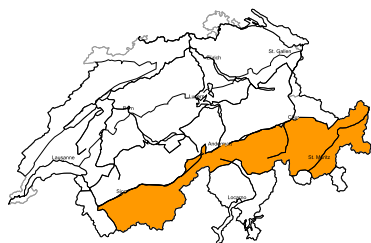

Avalanche danger



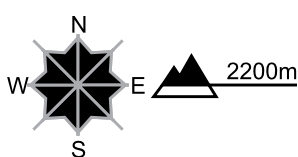
region A

Danger description

Even single winter sport participants can release avalanches in some places. These can be triggered in the old snowpack and reach dangerously large size. Whumpfung sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack can indicate the danger.

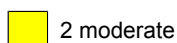
As a consequence of the northerly wind easily released snow drift accumulations have formed, in particular at elevated altitudes. These are to be avoided as far as possible.

Experience in the assessment of avalanche danger is required.

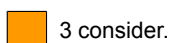
Danger levels



1 low



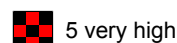
2 moderate
