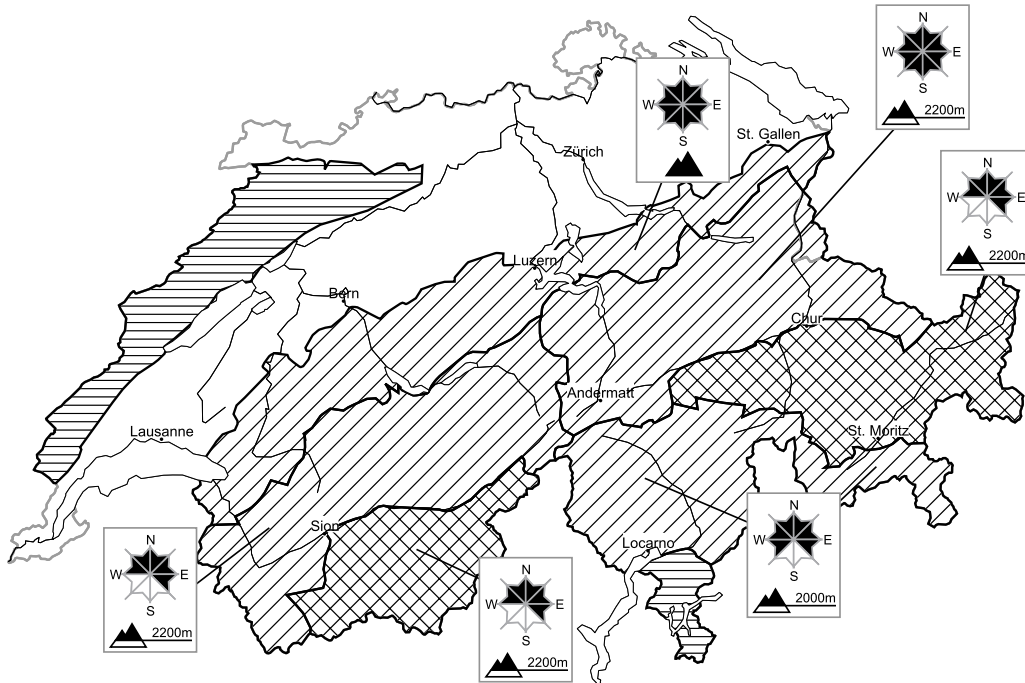

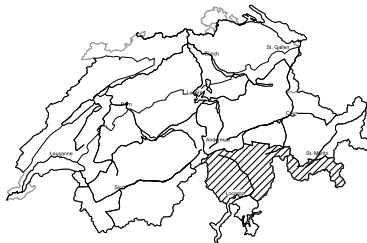

Avalanche danger



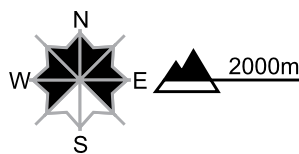
region E

Danger description

Avalanches can be released in the old snowpack, mostly by large additional loads. Caution is to be exercised at transitions from a shallow to a deep snowpack. These avalanche prone locations are rather rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Defensive route selection is advisable.

Somewhat older snow drift accumulations have formed in particular at elevated altitudes, also adjacent to the ridge line in all aspects. They are to be evaluated with care and prudence in steep terrain.
