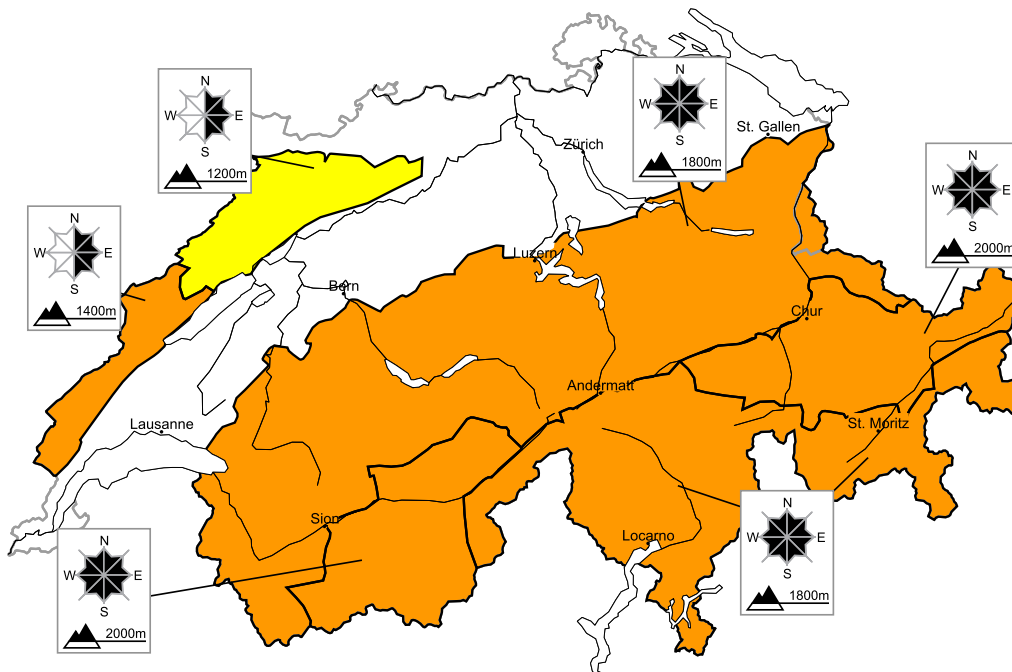


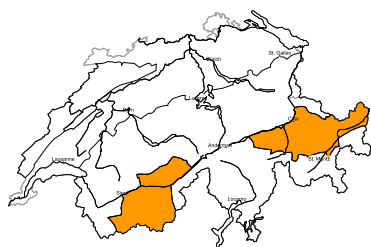

Avalanche danger

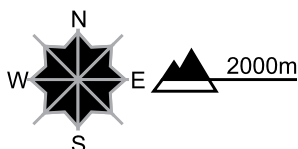


region C **Level 3, considerable**

Avalanche prone locations



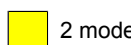
Danger description

In particular at elevated altitudes avalanche prone snow drift accumulations have formed. They can be released by a single winter sport participant and reach medium size. The fresh snow drift accumulations are to be avoided as far as possible. Avalanches can additionally in some places be released in the weakly bonded old snow. These can reach dangerously large size. Avalanche prone locations are to be found in areas where the snow cover is rather shallow, in particular on very steep west, north and east facing slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rather rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Whumpfung sounds can indicate the danger. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

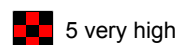
