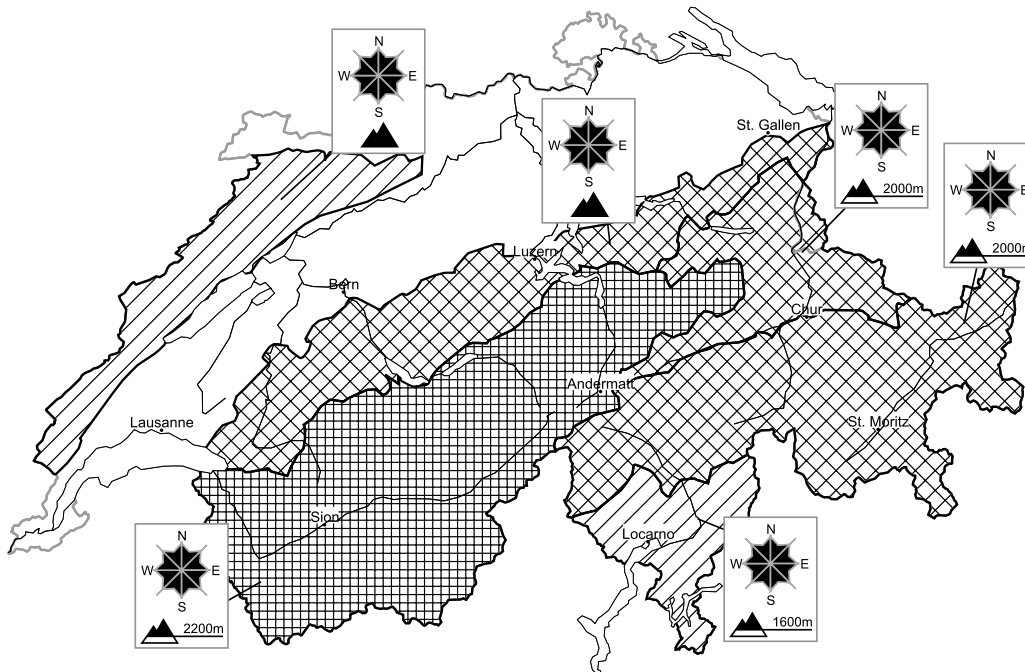


In the west and in the north a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

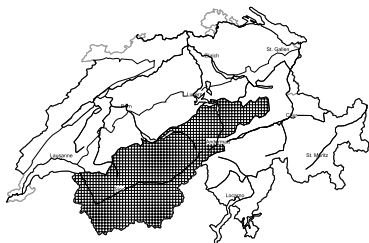

Avalanche danger



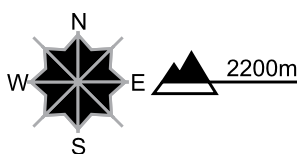
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather extensive snow drift accumulations will form. These can be released easily. As the snowfall becomes more intense more frequent natural avalanches are to be expected. Avalanches can additionally be released in the weakly bonded old snow in particular on very steep west, north and east facing slopes. From starting zones at higher altitudes avalanches, capable of reaching the valleys, must be expected in isolated cases. Exposed transportation routes can be endangered. The conditions are dangerous for snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes.

Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain a large number of small and medium-sized full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected below approximately 2200 m. Exposed transportation routes can be endangered.
