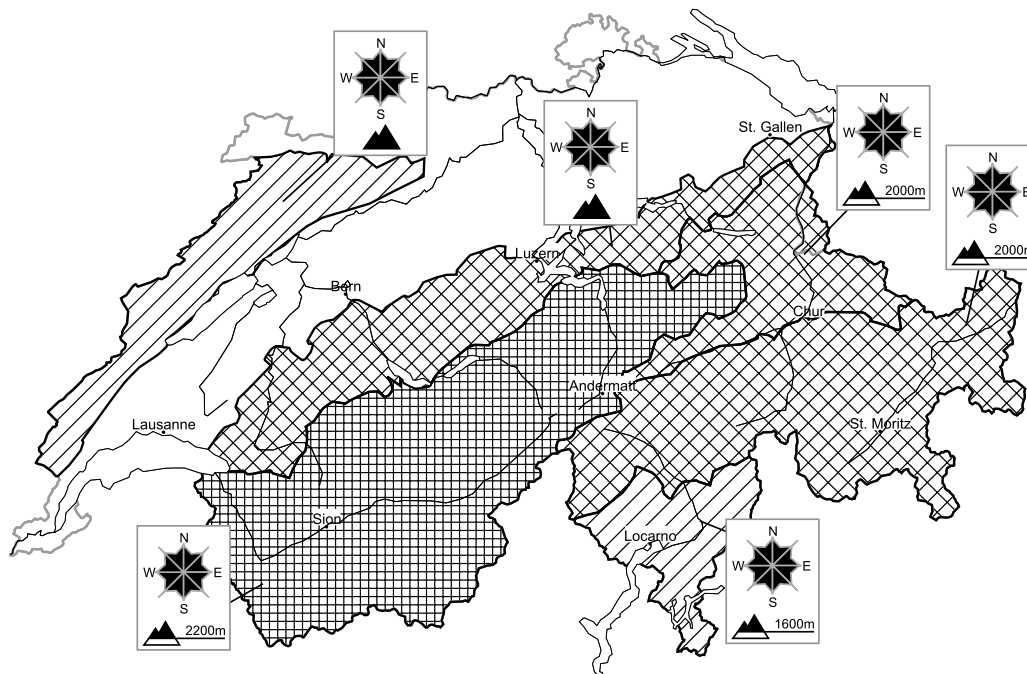


In the west and in the north a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

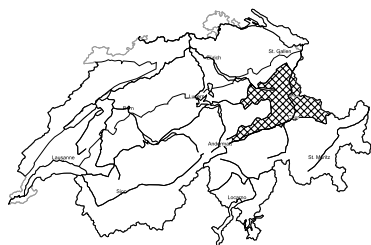

Avalanche danger



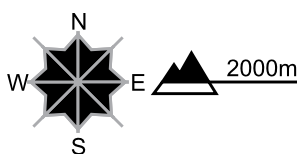
region B

Avalanche prone locations



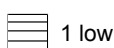
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather extensive snow drift accumulations will form. These can be released easily. As the day progresses more frequent natural avalanches are to be expected, including medium-sized ones. Experience and restraint are required.

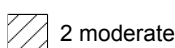
Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain a large number of small and medium-sized full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected below approximately 2000 m. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered.

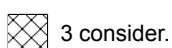
Danger levels



1 low



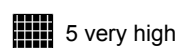
2 moderate
