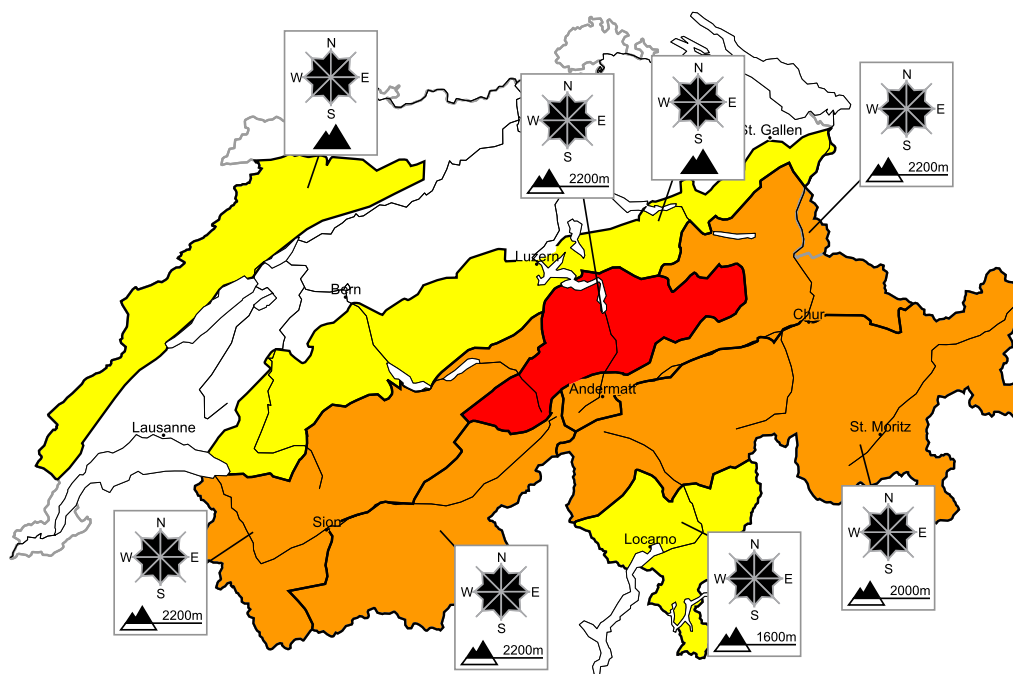


During the night a high avalanche danger will persist in some regions

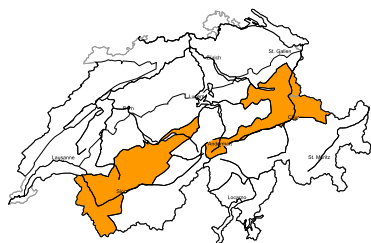

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather extensive snow drift accumulations have formed. Avalanches can be released easily and reach medium size. Natural avalanches are possible in particular during the night. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

Wet and full-depth avalanches

Small and medium-sized full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected below approximately 2200 m. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered, this applies in particular during the night.
