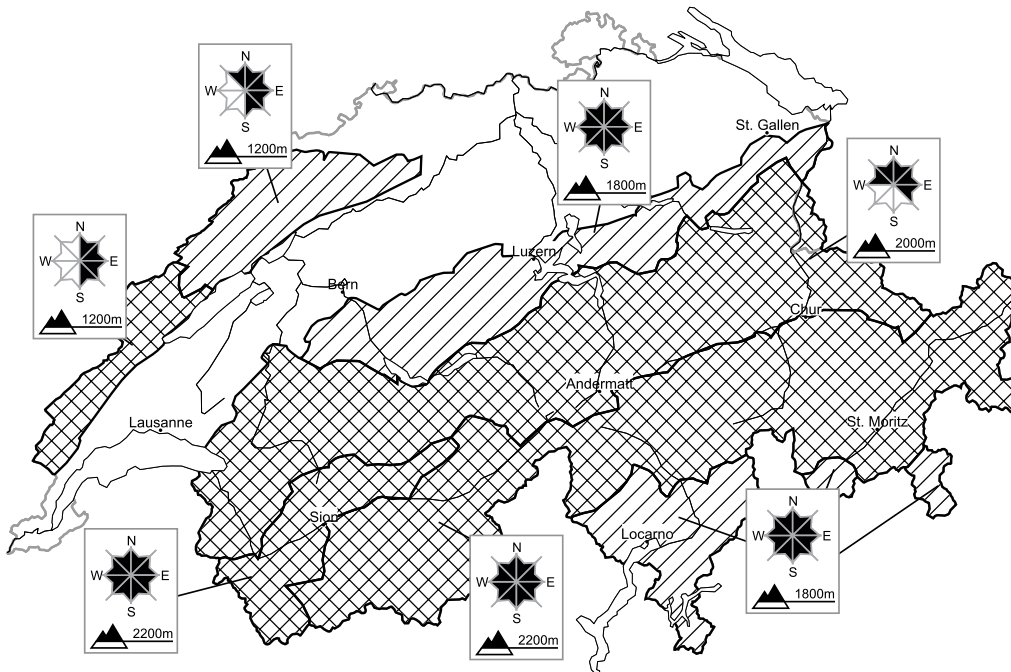


# Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

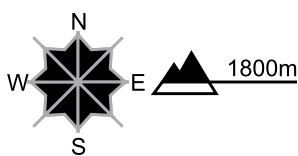
**region E**

**Snow drifts, old snow**

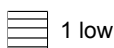
**Avalanche prone locations**



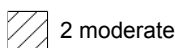
**Danger description**

As a consequence of the strong wind mostly small snow drift accumulations will form, in particular on south facing slopes. Additionally in very isolated cases avalanches can also be released in the old snowpack, especially on north facing slopes. Mostly avalanches are small. Backcountry touring calls for careful route selection.

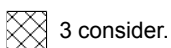

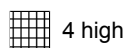

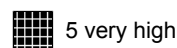
