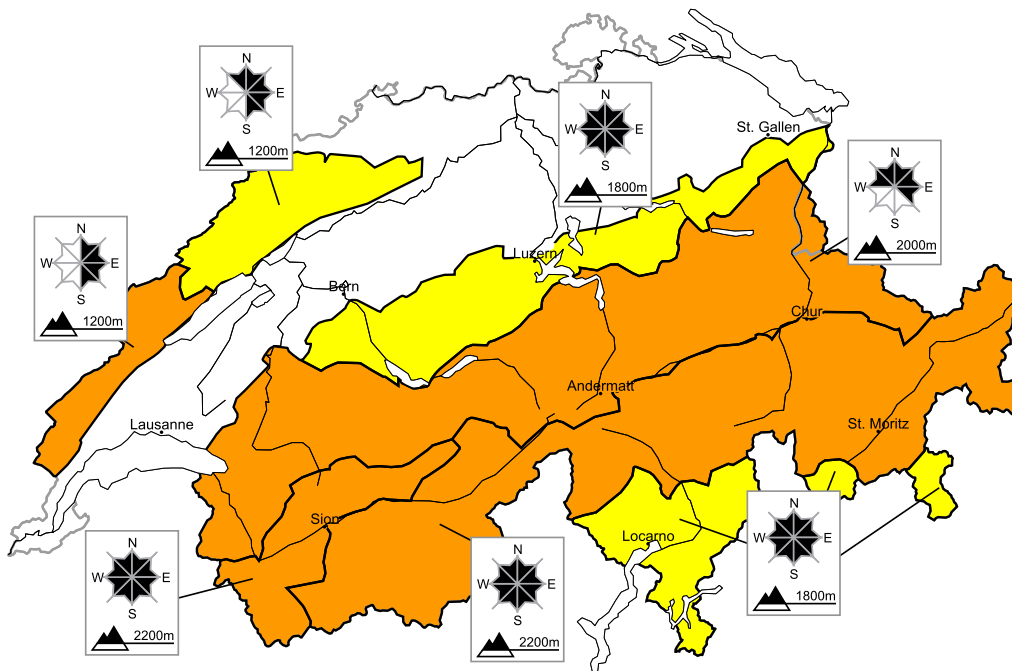

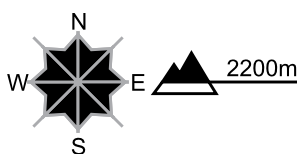

#### Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and strong wind easily released snow drift accumulations will form. These represent the main danger. Avalanches can be released, even by a single winter sport participant and reach medium size. Individual natural avalanches are possible.

Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

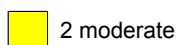
### Full-depth avalanches

Individual full-depth avalanches are possible below approximately 2200 m.

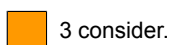

1 low



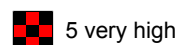
2 moderate
