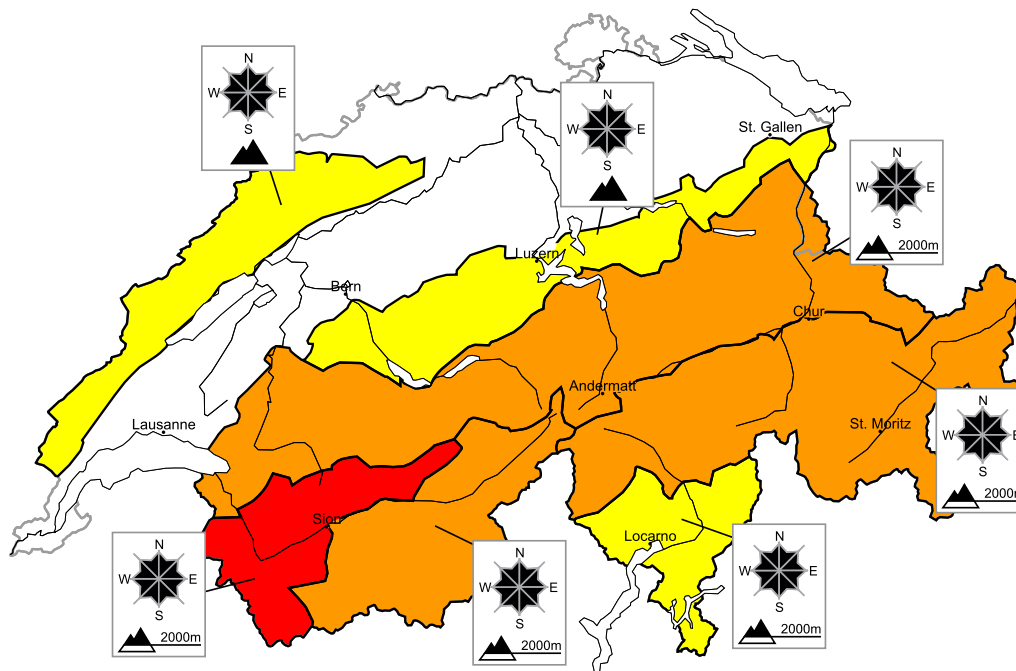


In the west a high avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

Avalanche danger



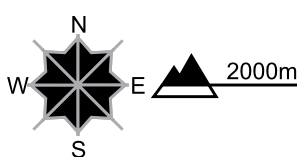
region B

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather dangerous snow drift accumulations will form. Additionally avalanches can penetrate near-ground layers of the snowpack and reach medium size. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger. An increasing number of natural avalanches are to be expected as the snowfall becomes more intense, this applies especially in the afternoon. Danger level 4 (high) will be reached. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered.

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
