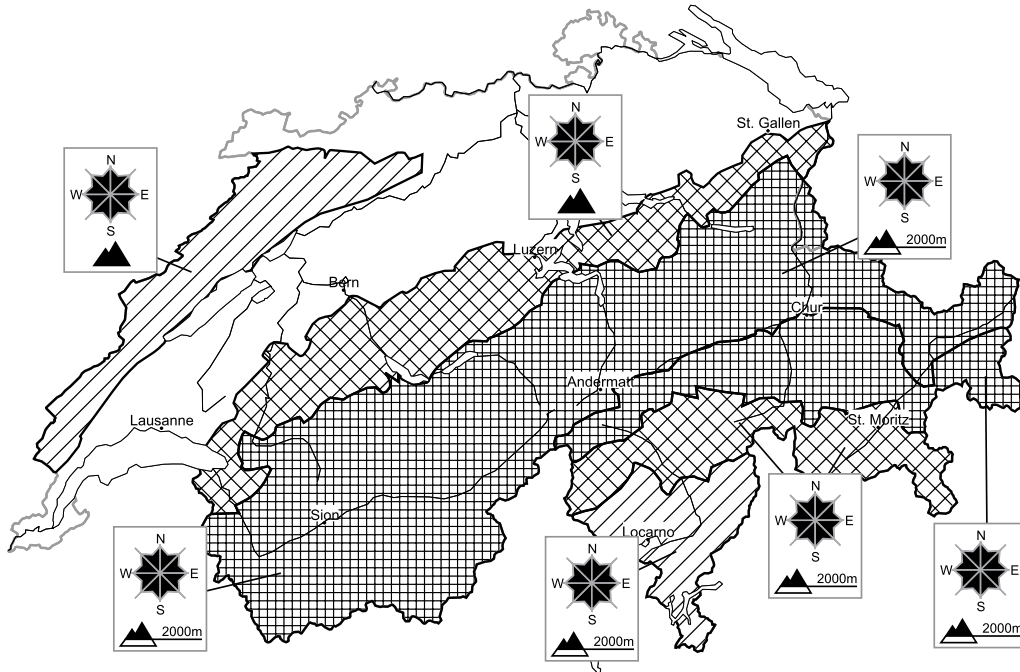

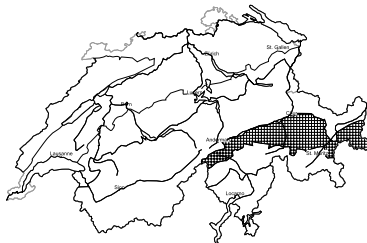

Avalanche danger



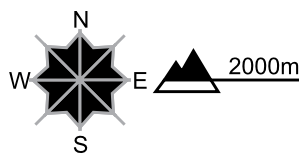
region B

Avalanche prone locations



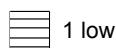
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather dangerous snow drift accumulations will form. Additionally avalanches can be triggered in the old snowpack. More frequent natural avalanches are to be expected, including medium-sized ones. The danger level 4 (high) will be reached in the late morning. The danger exists primarily in alpine snow sports terrain. Avalanches capable of reaching valley bottoms and endangering exposed transportation routes are unlikely to occur.

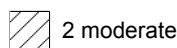
Wet avalanches

As a consequence of the rain wet avalanches are to be expected, especially below approximately 2000 m.

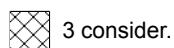

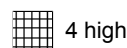
