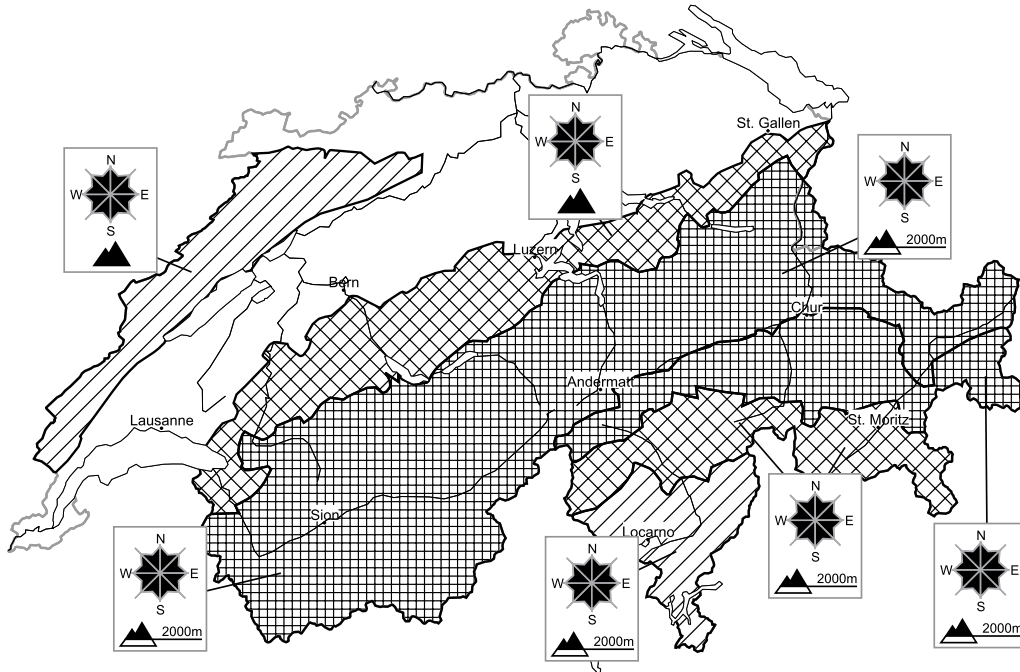

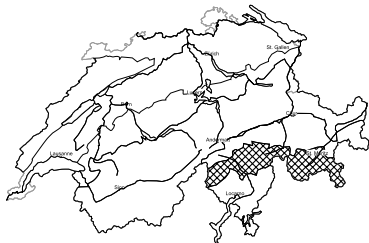

Avalanche danger



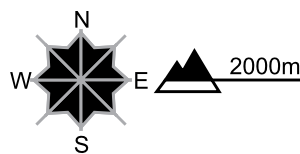
region D

Snow drifts, old snow

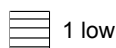
Avalanche prone locations



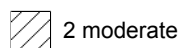
Danger description

As a consequence of the strong wind easily released snow drift accumulations have formed. Additionally in some places avalanches can be released in the old snowpack and reach dangerously large size. These avalanche prone locations are to be found in areas where the snow cover is rather shallow and at transitions from a shallow to a deep snowpack. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

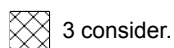
Danger levels



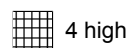
