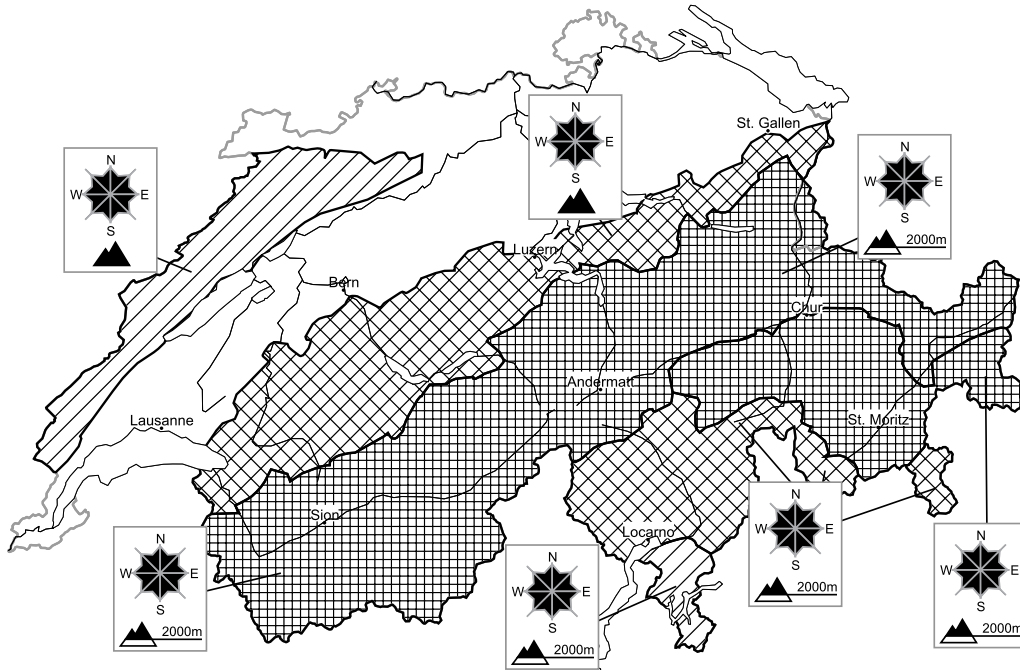

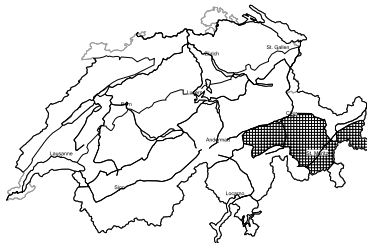

#### Avalanche prone locations



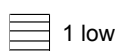
#### Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are very prone to triggering. Additionally avalanches can be triggered in the old snowpack. The danger exists in particular in alpine snow sports terrain. Numerous small and medium-sized natural avalanches are to be expected. In isolated cases, however, large avalanches capable of endangering exposed parts of transportation routes are also possible. The danger of natural avalanches will decrease during the day. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and great restraint.

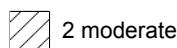
### Wet avalanches

Below approximately 2000 m wet avalanches are to be expected, in the event of rain in particular during the night.

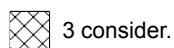
#### Danger levels



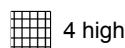
1 low
