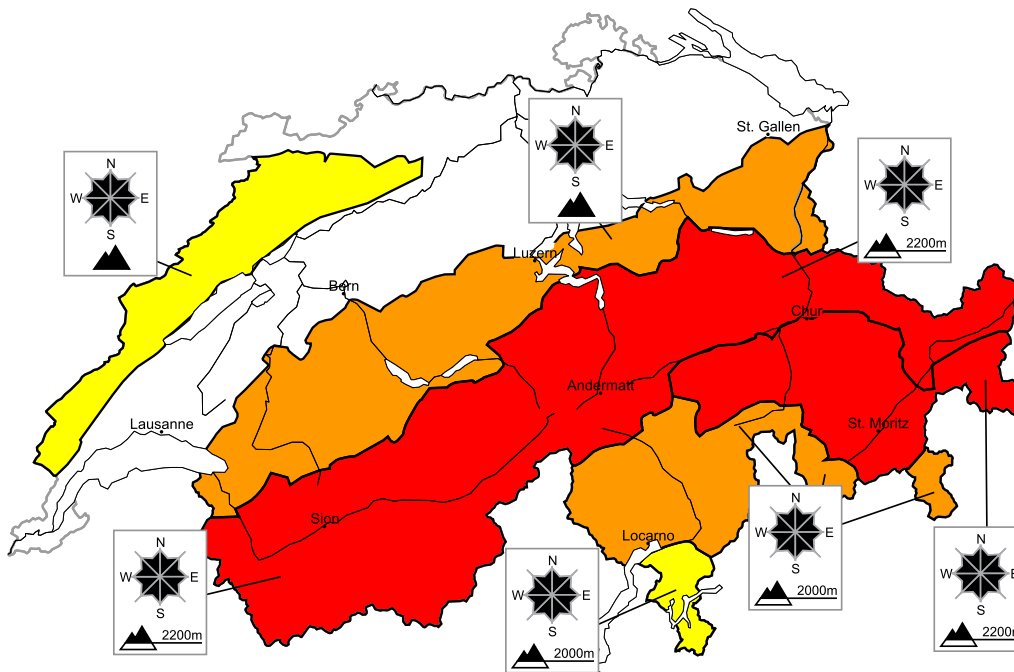


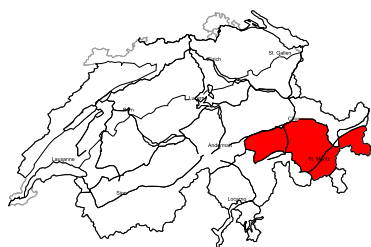

Avalanche danger

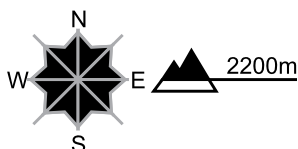


region B **Level 4, high**

Avalanche prone locations



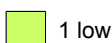
Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are prone to triggering. Additionally avalanches can be triggered in the old snowpack. Natural avalanches are possible. They can reach large size in isolated cases. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered. The danger of natural avalanches will decrease during the day. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and great restraint.

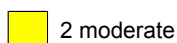
Wet avalanches

Below approximately 2200 m more wet avalanches are possible.

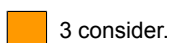
Danger levels



1 low



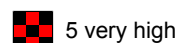
2 moderate
