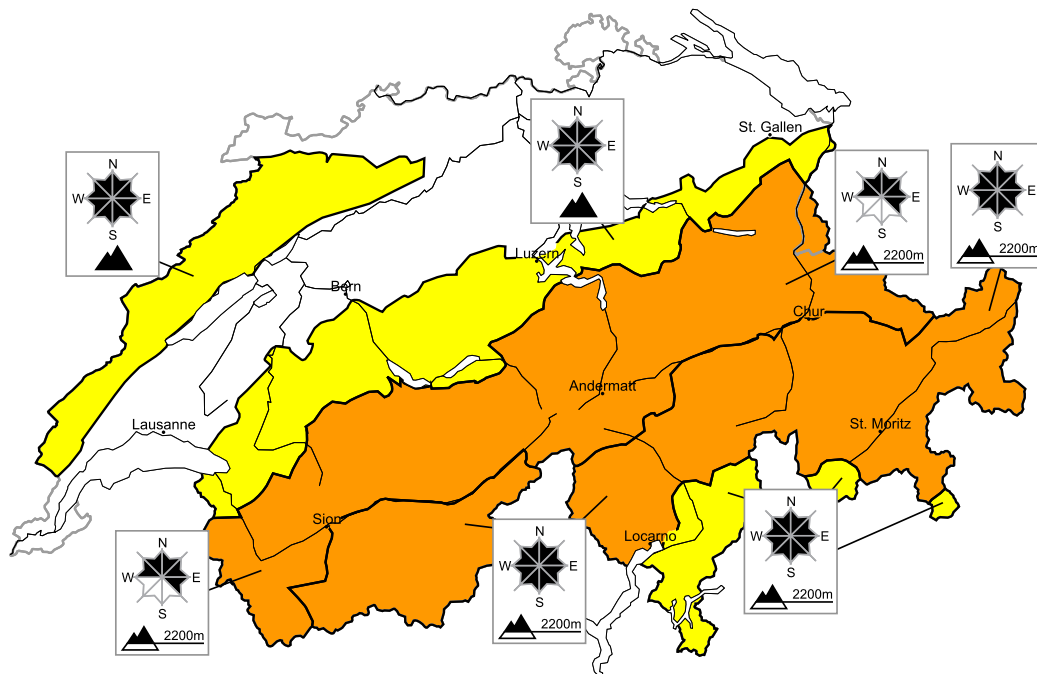


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

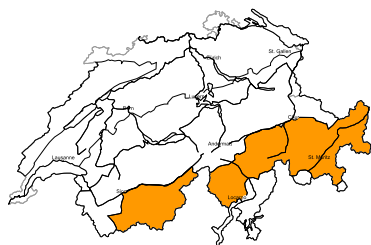

Avalanche danger



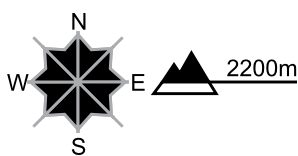
region A

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in some cases still prone to triggering. As a consequence of the southerly wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches. These can penetrate near-ground layers of the snowpack and reach dangerously large size.

Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

Wet and full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2200 m full-depth and wet avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects.

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
