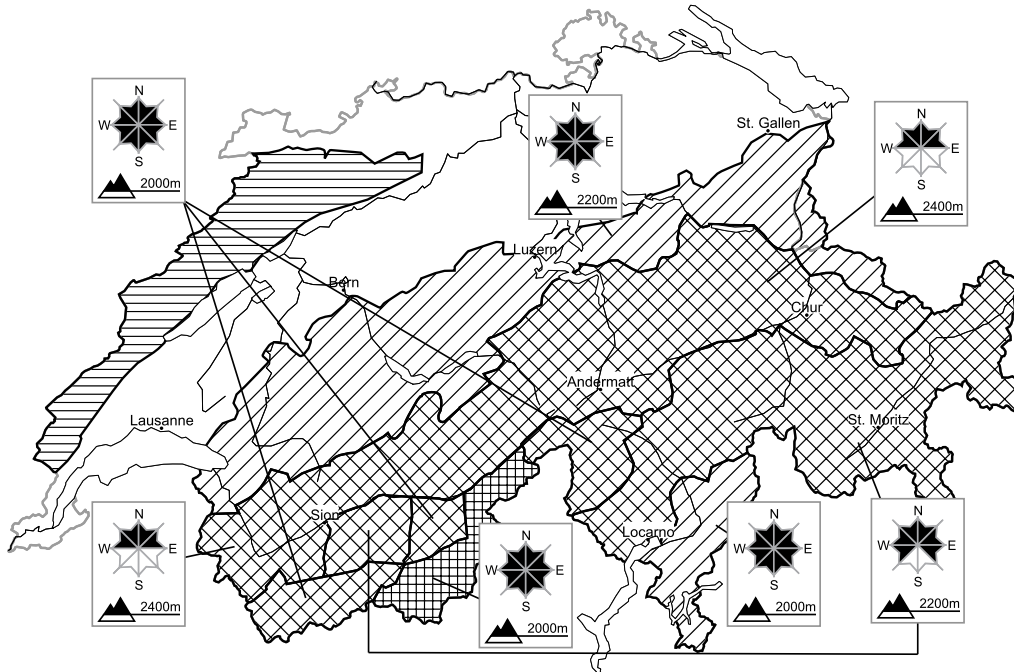


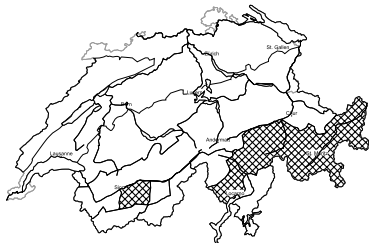
In southern Upper Valais a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

Avalanche danger

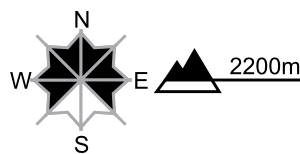


region C **Level 3, considerable**

Danger description

As a consequence of the southerly wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches. These can penetrate near-ground layers of the snowpack and reach dangerously large size. The somewhat older snow drift accumulations can be released, especially by large additional loads. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

Wet and full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2200 m full-depth and wet avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects.
