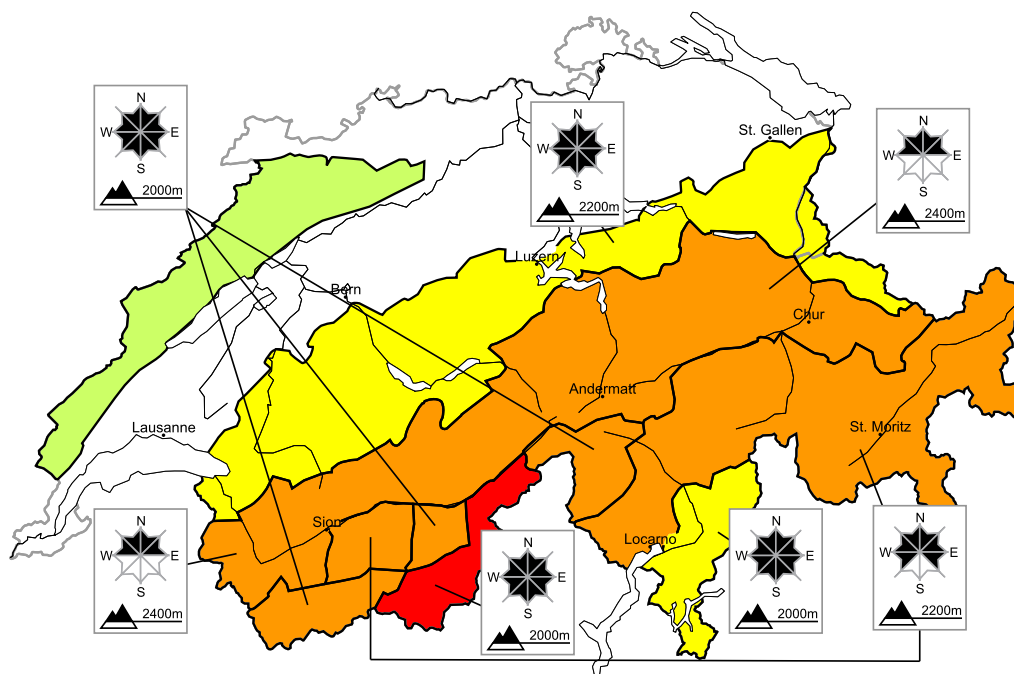


# In southern Upper Valais a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

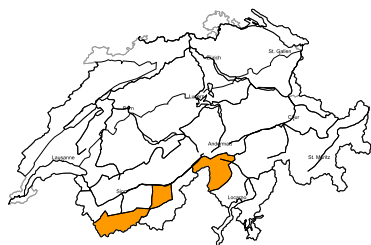

## Avalanche danger



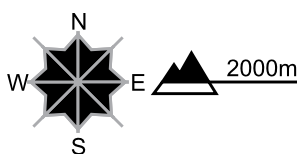
**region B**

### Fresh snow and snow drifts, old snow

#### Avalanche prone locations



#### Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind avalanche prone snow drift accumulations will form. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches. These can penetrate deep layers and reach dangerously large size. The danger of avalanches will increase during the day. An increasing number of natural dry avalanches are possible. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience and restraint.

### Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain more frequent full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2000 m.
