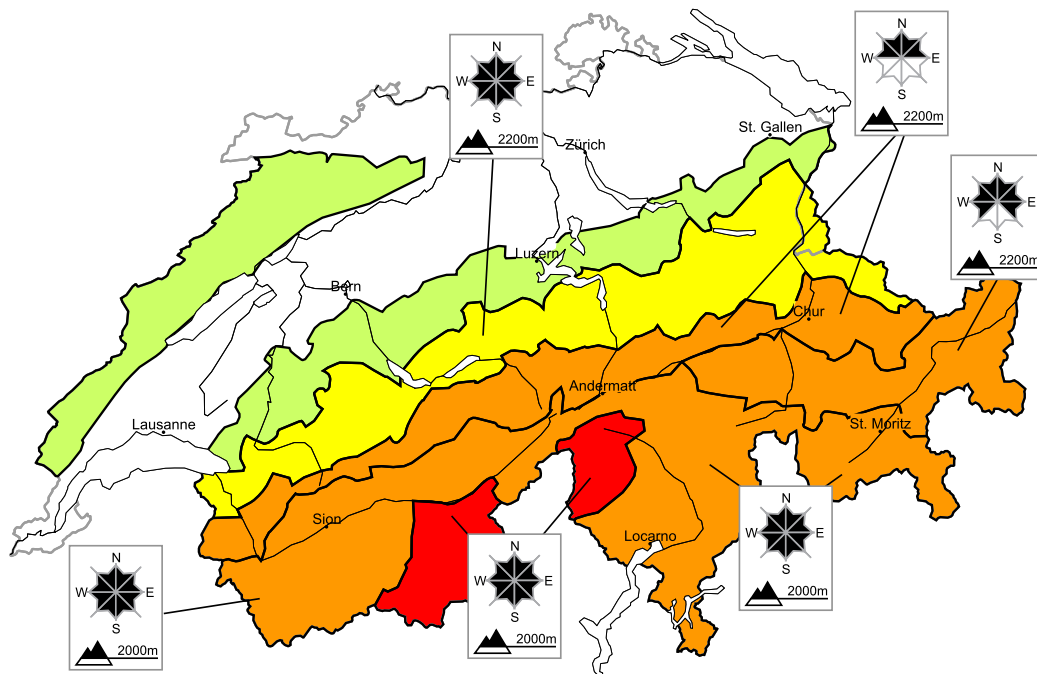


In southern Upper Valais and in northern Ticino a high avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

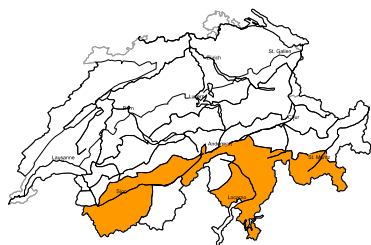

Avalanche danger



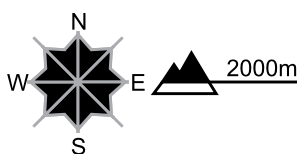
region B

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released easily, even by a single winter sport participant. Natural avalanches are possible. Additionally avalanches can be triggered in the old snowpack. Avalanches can reach dangerously large size. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and great restraint.

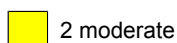
Wet and full-depth avalanches

More full-depth and wet avalanches are possible, in particular on steep slopes below approximately 2000 m as well as on road cut slopes.

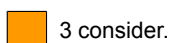
Danger levels



1 low



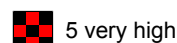
2 moderate
