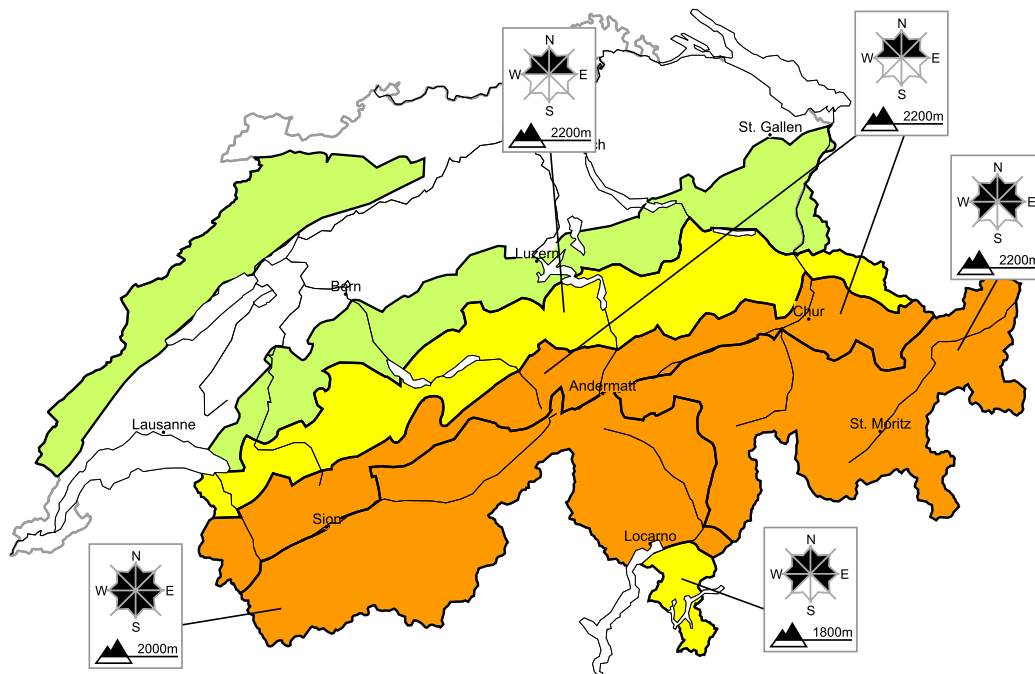


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

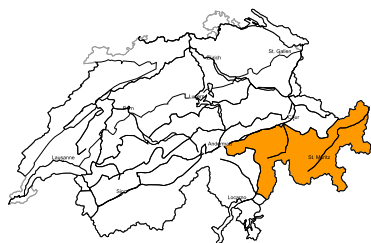

Avalanche danger



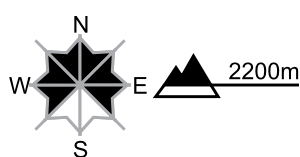
region B

Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. Avalanches can penetrate near-ground layers of the snowpack and reach dangerously large size. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
