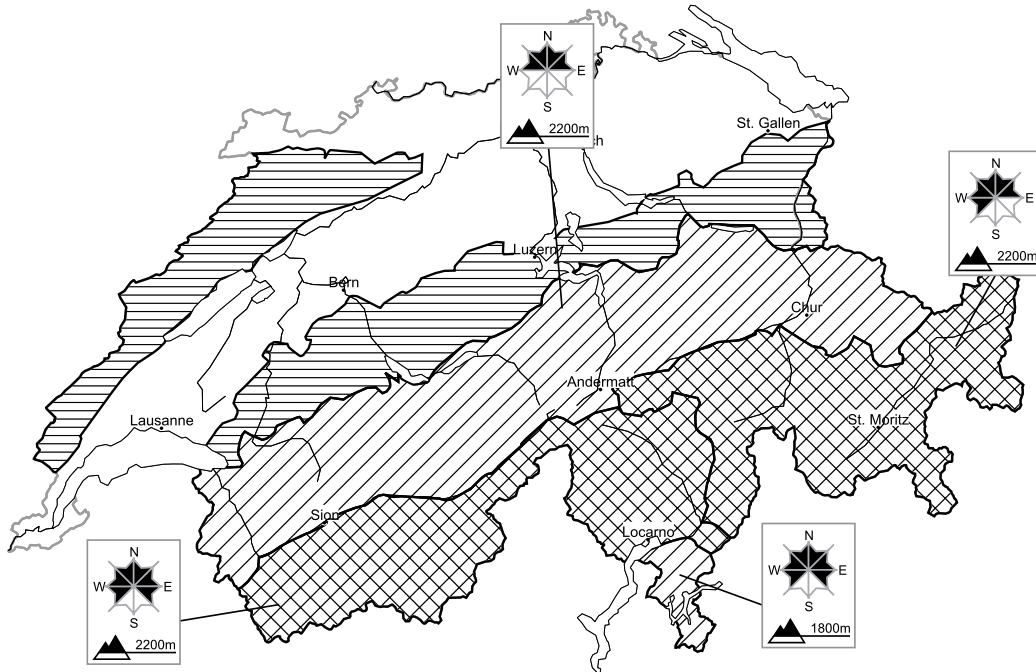


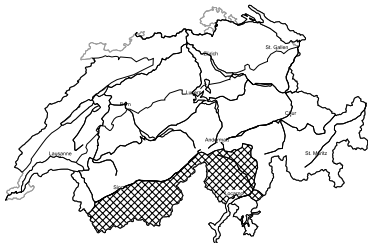

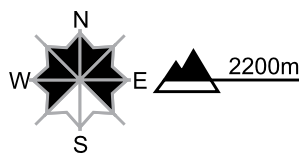


region A Level 3, considerable

Avalanche prone locations



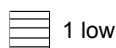
Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations can still be released in some cases, in particular at transitions from a shallow to a deep snowpack, when entering gullies and bowls for example. Avalanches can reach quite a large size. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

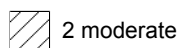
Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth and wet avalanches are possible, in particular on steep slopes below approximately 2200 m as well as on road cut slopes.

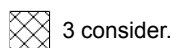
Danger levels



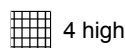

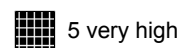
2 moderate
