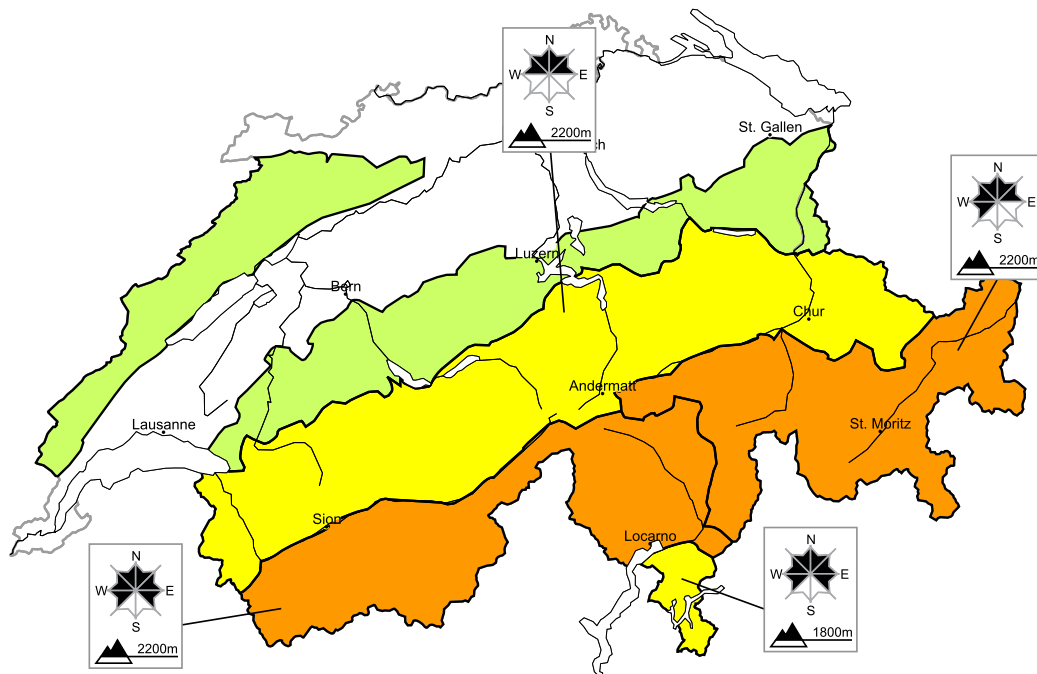


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

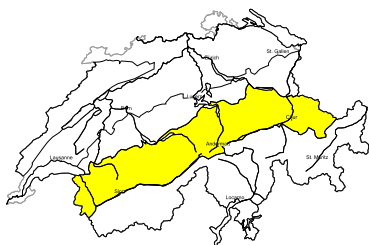

Avalanche danger



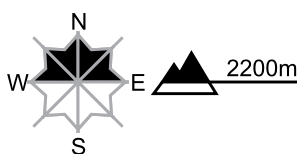
region C

Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations are in some cases still prone to triggering. These are rather small. They are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. Careful route selection is recommended.

Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2400 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
