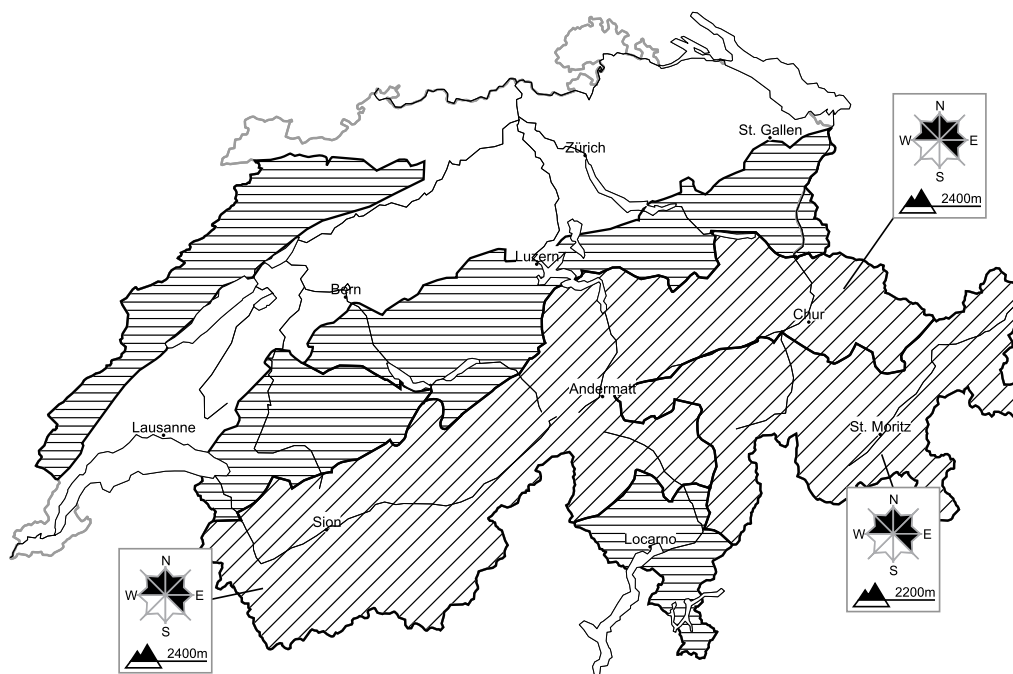


A generally favourable avalanche situation will prevail. Fresh snow drifts require caution

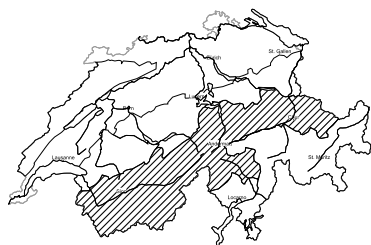

Avalanche danger



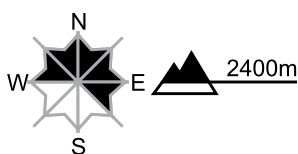
region B

Danger description

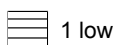
In the late morning a widespread favourable avalanche situation will prevail. Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in near-surface layers.

As a consequence of the sometimes strong wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations will form, this applies in particular in the afternoon. Avalanches can be released easily, but they will be small in most cases. Caution is to be exercised in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in pass areas above approximately 2000 m. Careful route selection is recommended.

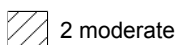
Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

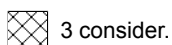
Danger levels



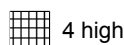

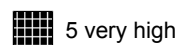
2 moderate
