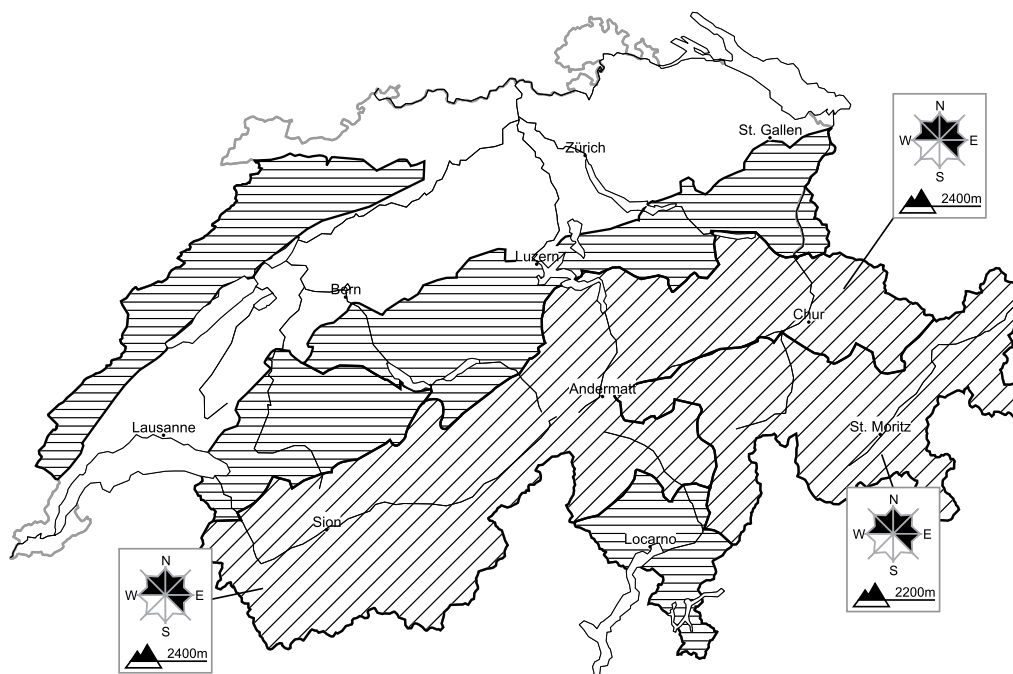


A generally favourable avalanche situation will prevail. Fresh snow drifts require caution

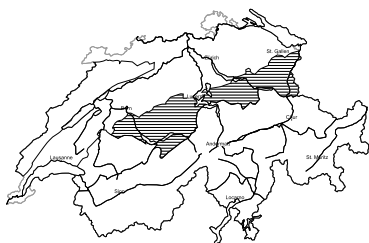

Level 1, low



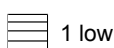
Snow drifts

The early morning will see favourable conditions over a wide area. As a consequence of the sometimes strong wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations will form, especially at high altitude. These are only small but can be released easily. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase as the day progresses. Restraint should be exercised because avalanches can sweep people along and give rise to falls.

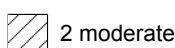
Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

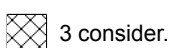
Danger levels



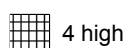

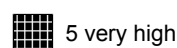
