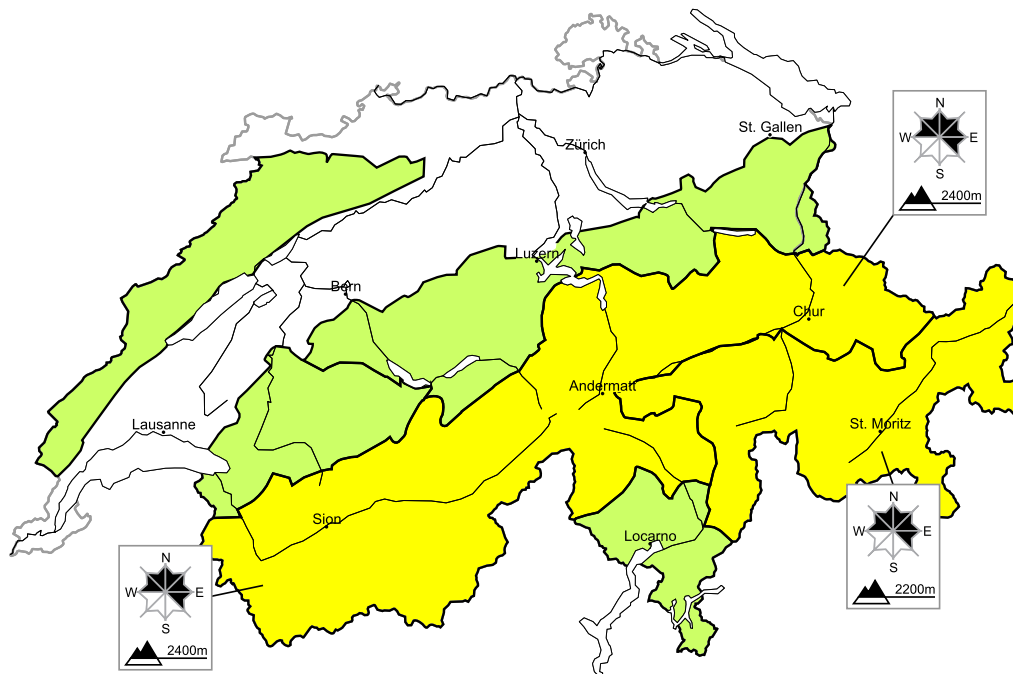


A generally favourable avalanche situation will prevail. Fresh snow drifts require caution

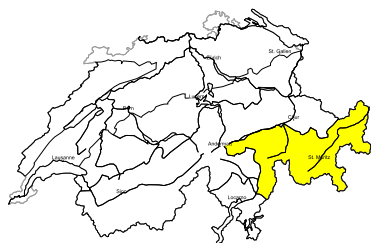

Avalanche danger



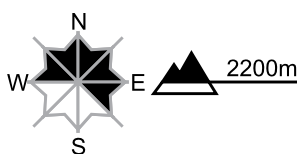
region A

Danger description

Winter sport participants can release avalanches only in isolated cases, in particular in areas where the snow cover is rather shallow. Avalanches can in some cases be triggered in near-ground layers and reach dangerously large size. In some localities small snow drift accumulations will form, this applies especially in the afternoon.

Defensive route selection is recommended. Very steep slopes are to be traversed by snow sport participants one at a time.

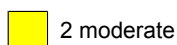
Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

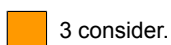
Danger levels
