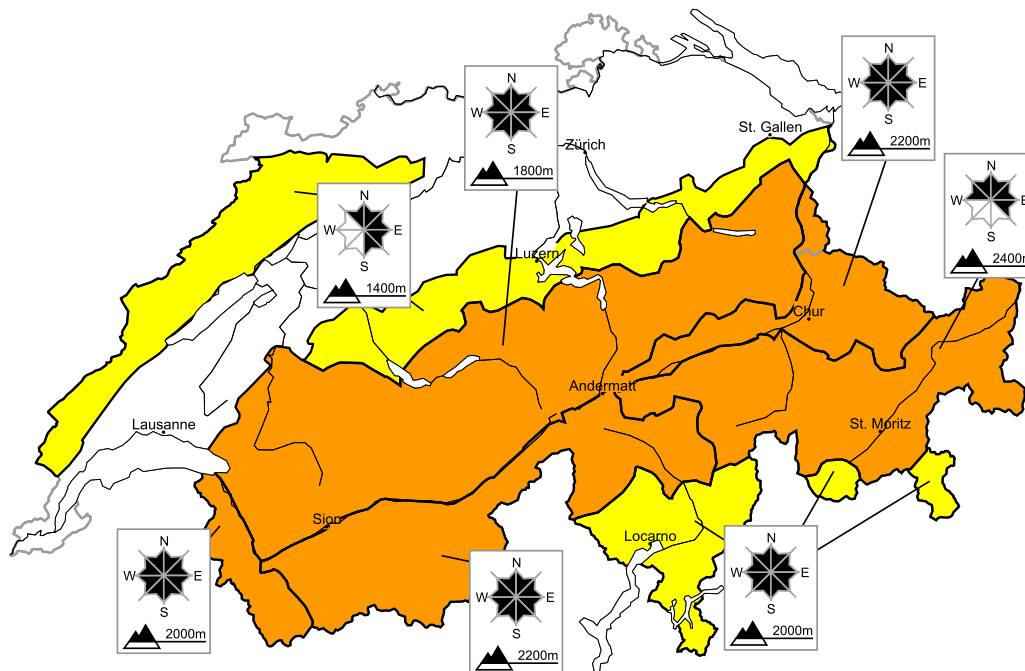


# Significant increase in avalanche danger as a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather

### Fresh snow and snow drifts

#### Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather snow drift accumulations will form. These will be deposited on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack on west to north to east facing aspects. Avalanches can be released very easily. In the afternoon more frequent natural avalanches are to be expected, including medium-sized ones. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

### Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
