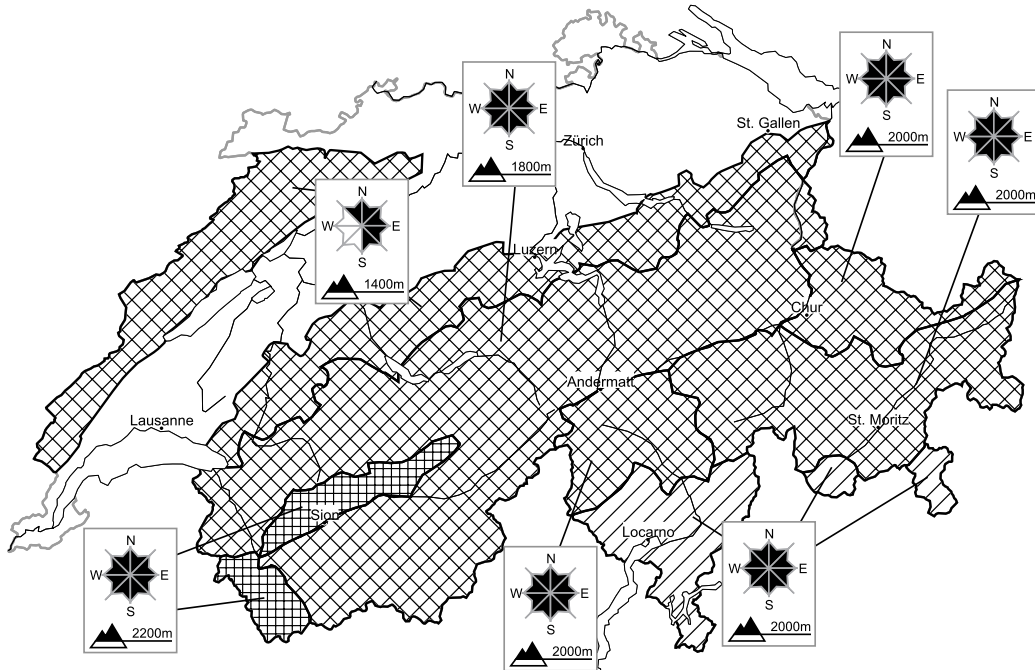


Stormy weather and fresh snow: High avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

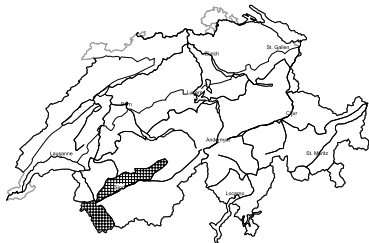

Avalanche danger



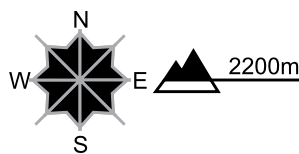
region A

Danger description

The danger exists primarily in alpine snow sports terrain. As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather large snow drift accumulations have formed. They are lying on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack on west to north to east facing aspects. Avalanches can be released very easily or triggered naturally. They can reach medium size. Individual large avalanches are possible. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered. Backcountry touring calls for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and great restraint.

Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
