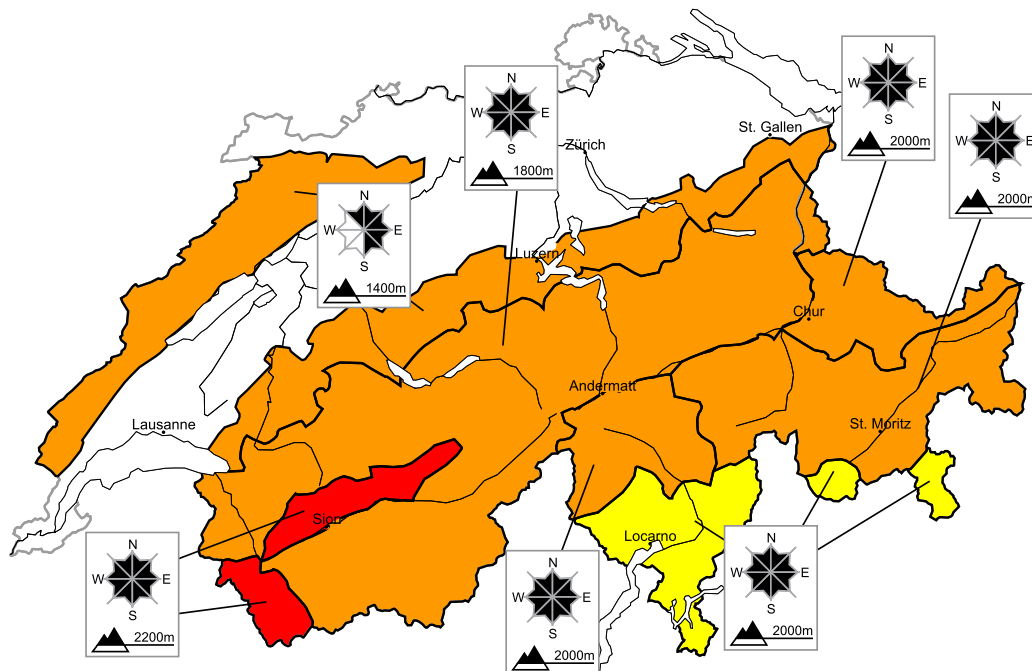


Stormy weather and fresh snow: High avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

Avalanche danger



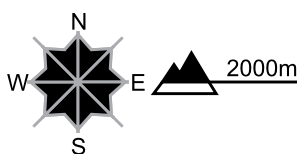
region C

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather snow drift accumulations have formed. They are lying on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack on west to north to east facing aspects. Avalanches can be released very easily and reach medium size. Natural avalanches are to be expected as the day progresses. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

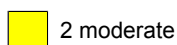
Full-depth avalanches

More full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

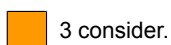
Danger levels



1 low



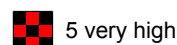
2 moderate
