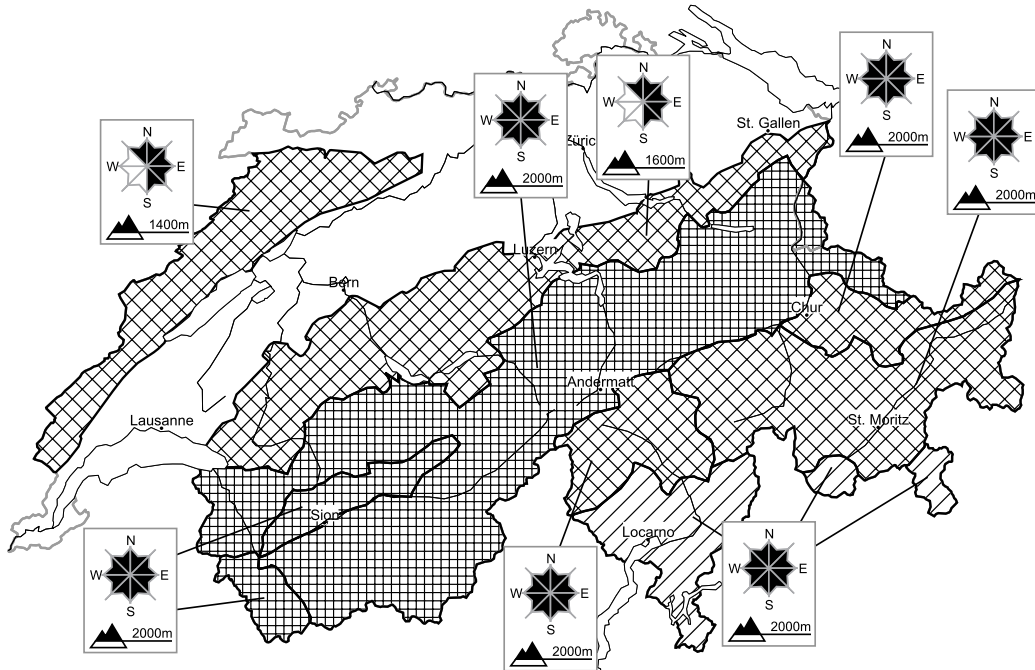


Stormy weather and fresh snow: In the west and in the north a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

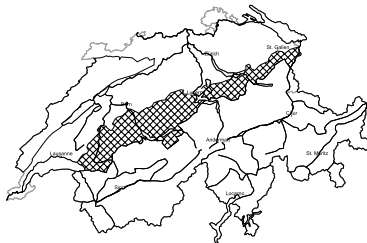

Avalanche danger



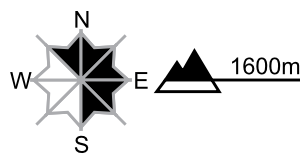
region E

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather snow drift accumulations have formed. These are mostly only small but can be released easily. The snow drift accumulations are to be avoided in steep terrain. Backcountry touring calls for careful route selection.

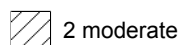
Wet and full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 1200 m moist snow slides and avalanches are to be expected as a consequence of the rain. Individual full-depth avalanches can also occur, especially below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

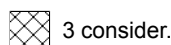
Danger levels



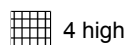
1 low
