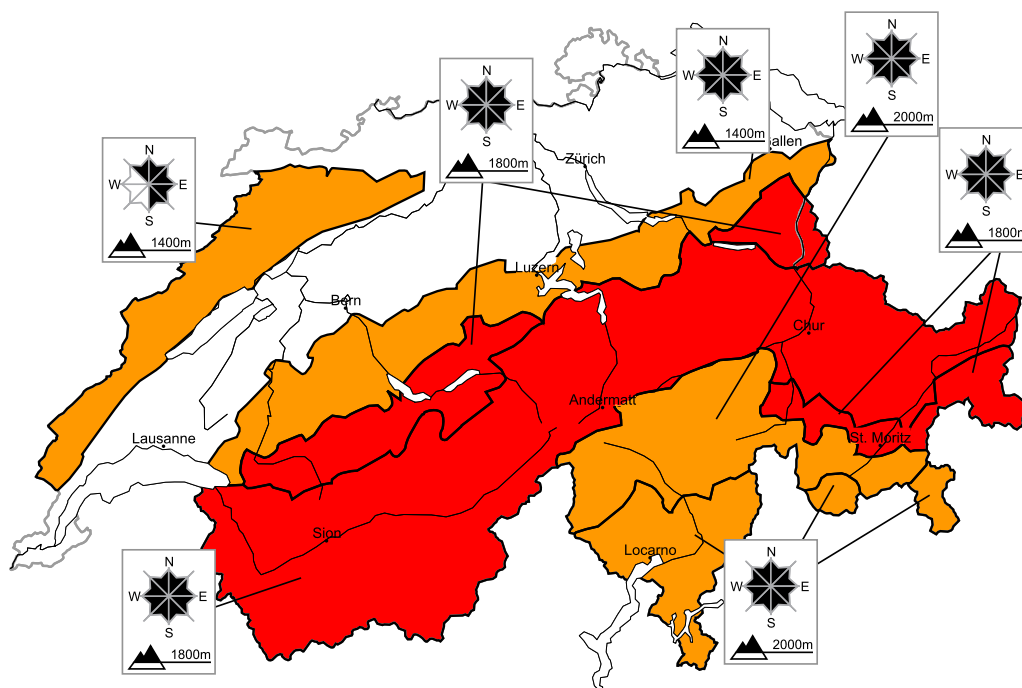


As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

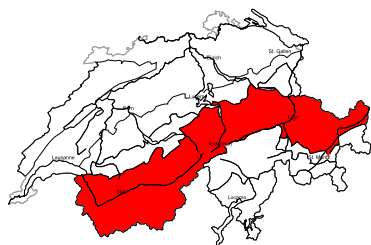

Avalanche danger



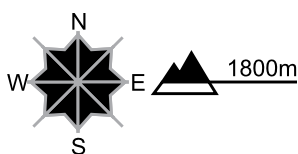
region A

Danger description

More snow than expected has fallen in Grisons. The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are prone to triggering. Natural avalanches are to be expected. Avalanches can in some cases release deeper layers of the snowpack and reach large size. Exposed buildings and exposed parts of transportation routes are endangered in some cases. Safety measures are to be reviewed. Snow sport participants with little experience in the assessment of avalanche danger should remain on the open pistes.

Full-depth avalanches

Individual full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks. Slides are to be expected on cut slopes.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
