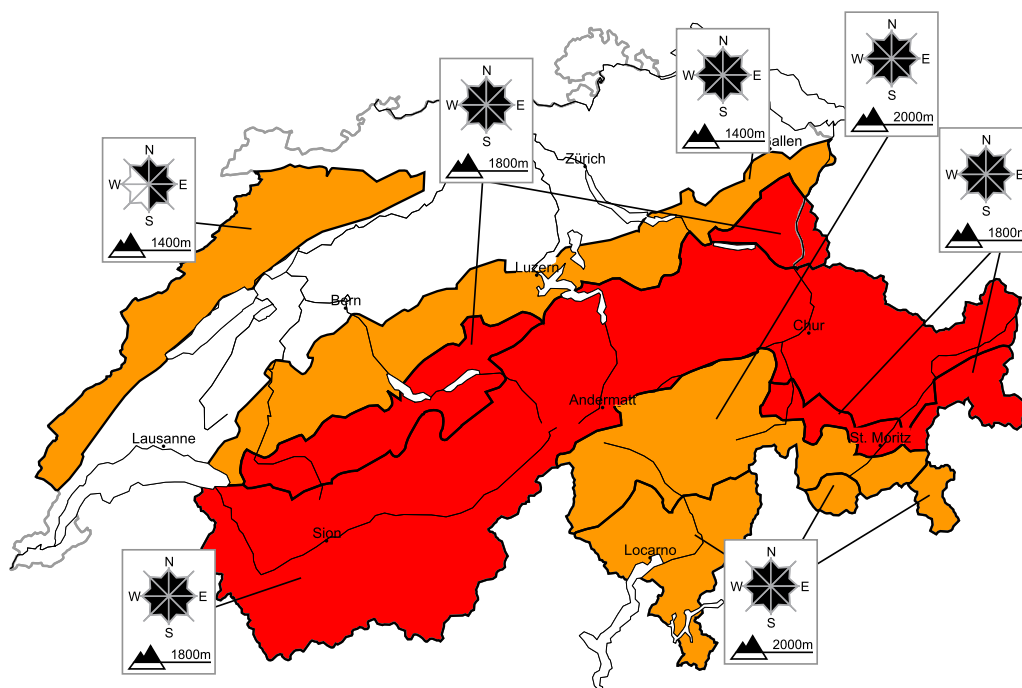


# As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather a high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

## Avalanche danger



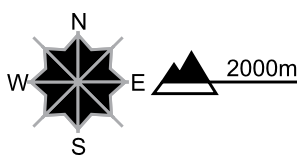
**region D**

#### Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are prone to triggering. Avalanches can be released, even by a single winter sport participant. They can penetrate deep layers and reach dangerously large size. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

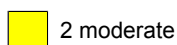
### Full-depth avalanches

Individual full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

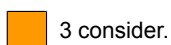
**Danger levels**



1 low



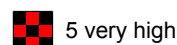
2 moderate
